Payoff

- This program adequately prepares students for policy-making positions
- Graduates who complete this program are connected with influential policymakers and network with professionals
- Master's Degree in shorter amount of time from accredited top-tier research institution

Motivator

- The accelerated program allows students to graduate a semester early
- By day, students take classes taught by experts and scholars
- By night, students gain experience working at their policy apprenticeships

Barrier Breaker

- Not every student has the means to move to a new city for an extended period of time
- The near \$60,000 tuition is not feasible for many students, especially after undergraduate tuition expenses
- The accelerated speed of the material could be too quick-moving for some students

Ask

- Students should consider participating in this program, as prepared and informed policy makers benefit the entire country
- Consider accelerated program to save in overall time and tuition
