

Johan Oviedo

Throws: R | 6'5, 245 | Age: 24

Physical: Big durable young right handed starter. Very tall extra-large frame. Mature build with no projection left.

Mechanics: Extreme side saddle start with high ¾ arm slot. Short and clean arm action in back and wide outward arm action coming forward. Hides ball well in front and back for added deception.

Fastball	Struggles with command, but when effective can be a decent strikeout pitch	93-95 L: 93 T:96 Grade: 50
Curveball	Small factor in overall selection, more of fastball/slider diet. Lacked control to throw for strikes.	77-80 L:77 T:81 Grade: 40
Slider	Didn't slide well. Has ability to produce flyout when productive	83-85 L: 81 T:86 Grade: 50
Changeup	Least thrown pitch, not thrown for a strike. Struggled with control	88 T:88 Grade: 30

Overall, Heavy fastball/slider pitcher who uses his curveball as a third pitch, and rarely uses his changeup. Solid arm who can give you innings when needed. Seems like a better long reliever option but could serve as spot start if needed. Struggles with control the most, if he can start to control his pitches it will only continue to improve his stock.

Matthew Liberatore

Throws: L | 6'4, 200 | Age: 22

Physical: Younger big lefty with tall frame. Somewhat slim, but overall, a lean athletic build.

Mechanics: Starts straight on third base side with semi windup. Long ¾ arm slot. Hides ball well in the front, but long arm stretch when delivering shows ball in the back.

Fastball	Decent strike pitch. Keeps his fastballs high in the zone for the most part and produces ground balls.	93-95 L: 91 T: 95 Grade: 45
Curveball	Solid ¾ downward rotation. Effective pitch that also causes ground balls. Consistent mid 70's pitch.	73-75 L: 73 T: 76 Grade: 55
Slider	Commands pitch in the zone to consistently cause foul balls.	85-87 L:85 T: 89 Grade: 50
Sinker	One of his go to pitches. Causes majority of ground balls.	91-93 L:88 T:95 Grade: 50
Changeup	High velocity pitch but struggled to throw pitch for a strike.	85-87 L:85 T: 87 Grade: 40

Overall, has good repertoire of pitches to choose from. Has trouble commanding some of his off speed pitches. Solid use of locating fastball and does well with keeping slider in the zone to challenge hitters, by having them foul it off. Seems like he could be a better option as long middle reliever than starter if control issues remain.

Junior Fernandez

Throws: R | 6'3, 215 | Age: 25

Physical: Middle 20's aged righty with average height. Big thicker frame. No future physical projection left.

Mechanics: Delivers from the stretch, but still able to hide the ball well in front and behind, through his delivery.

Sinker	High velocity pitch, effective early to cause ground balls. Lost touch as time went on to give up hit and walk.	97-99 L:97 T:99 Grade: 55
Slider	Solid secondary pitch to attack hitters well. Causes ground ball.	87-89 L: 87 T:90 Grade: 50
Changeup	Third used pitch with high velocity to keep hitters guessing.	90-92 L: 90 T: 91 Grade: 50

Overall, heavy diet of sinker/slider action. Uses his high velocity to attack hitters and can pitch for strikes. Tends to struggle with command and location when pushed for extra workload. Solid middle reliever who can get through middle innings and could work way to back end reliever with more control in his approach.

Packy Naughton

Throws: L | 6'2 195 | Age: 26

Physical: Average height, young lefty with slimmer athletic build. Lengthy build for his height.

Mechanics: Delivered exclusively from the stretch with runners on. High $\frac{3}{4}$ arm slot with high leg kick to power towards the batter. Able to hide the ball well in front of body but shows in back with his lengthy delivery.

Fastball	Used pitch late to power through hitter. Uses mid 90's velocity to challenge hitter and generate strikeout.	92-94 L: 93 H: 94 Grade: 55
Sinker	Effective high velocity pitch to produce fly out.	92-94 L:92 H:94 Grade: 50
Change	Only used once, but able to produce fly out with mid 80's velocity	84 H:84 Grade: 50
Slider	Struggled to control and missed the zone. Wasn't able to challenge hitter because it kept missing the zone	79-81 L: 80 H: 81 Grade: 35

Overall, struggled with command and control early in high stress bases loaded situation. Never was able to gain control of his slider but focused on other pitches to help get out of the jam. Was able to calm down and do his job by locating his sinker and fastball to get out of the inning. Seems like he can be decent high leverage lefty pitcher down the stretch. If he sticks with fastball sinker as a one two punch and can work on control of slider, he can build a solid three pitch attack.

Ryan Helsley

Throws: R | 6'2, 230 | Age: 27

Physical: A bit under average height with a thicker build to his frame. Durable right hander in his upper 20's.

Mechanics: Pitches exclusively from the stretch and attacks hitter with high leg kick for added velocity. Hides the ball well in front and shows in back when coming around.

Fastball	Very high velocity pitch to strike down hitters. Strong command to keep hitters on their toes.	98-100 L: 98 H: 102 Grade: 65
Slider	Another high velocity pitch for off speed. Solid job controlling off speed to keep in the zone and throwing for strikes.	88-90 L: 88 H: 90 Grade: 60

Overall, very effective back end reliever. Uses his high velocity with fastball and off speed pitches to keep hitters off balance. Great job at combining his command and control to pitch around the zone and have hitters swing and miss. Successful strike out stuff with low ball ratio.
