The student attended parties on January 20th at the University of Michigan and on the 22nd at Michigan State University. Up to 200 people at these events could have been exposed. Officials are worried about exposure because Meningitis is spread through close contact. This includes kissing, sharing drinks and utensils. Both universities are holding events to distribute antibiotics to anyone that could have been exposed. No other cases have been identified.
