### Why are you running to be VP for education?

#### What makes you think you are the best person for the job?

I personally have experienced many issues with my personal tutor and lecture captures and felt like there was no one acting about it. That pushed me to be the person who will try to find solutions and therefore, help students that are in the same situation as me. With my experience and personal determination, I would want to ensure that students who may have to deal with issues like that will have someone who will stand on their behalf.

#### How exactly would your opinion box look like and how would it work?

It would be a suggestion box (of an extravagant colour, to make it stand out) placed in strategic spots around the University which will allow students to drop any suggestions or their own opinions about anything. This would allow a better communication between the students and the Student Union. It would also bring necessary data to enforce things in the University. For example, if one person shares their opinion on exam approaches, the University might ignore it, while if statistically half of the students have the same point of view, the University will have to consider it and act on it.

#### You've pledged more events - but what kind of events and how would you deliver this?

In my opinion, there is a lot of knowledge passed onto us however, I would like to create workshops that would deliver 'life skills'. I also would like to create more 'leadership and teamwork skills' workshops, which will enhance students satisfaction as well as their University experience.

I have a couple of more ideas but these are my main ones.

## What are your opinions on the university's freedom of speech issues and how would you help combat this?

I believe in freedom of speech and that everyone should be able to speak their mind. Of course, we would prefer to have open minded thoughts as long as they stay polite (we do not want people to use bad language towards each other). I would not tolerate people who would shut others down because of differing opinions. Once a wise man said, we all have different opinions but that does not mean that only one of them is correct.

#### What do you think of the government's Prevent scheme and its' use in the university?

For this question, I did not really know what to answer as I am an international student and I have never heard about it before. However, I will be doing some research regarding this.

## What do you make of the passing of the Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions motion at the last AGM, and its potential impact on learning?

I agree with the Student Union beliefs and that we should raise awareness of Palestinian issues around the University as well as BDS. I personally believe that the University and the Student Union should work together for this not to impact the student's studies. If I become VP of Education I will ensure that everyone is equally-treated and they can feel safe expressing themselves and not be labelled or targeted by anyone.

Polling is open till 1300 on Friday 16th March.

Should she win, Bouchamaoui will replace the outgoing Malek Arab in September.


