Over his six years of enrollment at Hogwarts, through a combination of injury, suspension and match cancellations, Harry Potter played in just nine total Quidditch matches for Gryffindor, compiling a record of seven wins and two losses.

Albus Dumbledore was in Gryffindor, showcasing his bravery and courage throughout his life. However, his early ambitions could have placed him in Slytherin. Minerva McGonagall was a Hatstall between Gryffindor and Ravenclaw, but her fiery nature and bravery solidify her place in Gryffindor.

Did you know that the Hogwarts' motto is "Draco Dormiens Nunquam Titillandus" which means "never tickle a sleeping dragon"? Each House represents one of the four classical elements: Fire (Gryffindor), Earth (Hufflepuff), Air (Ravenclaw), and Water (Slytherin). Each of these also represents one of the four states of matter: Plasma (Fire, Gryffindor), Gas (Air, Ravenclaw), Liquid (Water, Slytherin), and Solid (Earth, Hufflepuff).





Kuidditch Rundown

The object of the game of Quidditch is to score more points than your opponents. Players do this by scoring goals which is done by placing a slightly deflated volleyball called the Quaffle into the opposition's baskets giving them 10 points, and by capturing the Golden Snitch which is worth 30 points.

A Quidditch team is composed of seven people - three Chasers, two Beaters, a Keeper and a Seeker - with four balls in play (a Quaffle, two Bludgers and a Golden Snitch). This is the biggest issue with Quidditch that many fans of the series have pointed out. It's the biggest glaring flaw with the sport. Getting the Quaffle through the hoops only gives a team ten points while catching the Snitch ends the game and gives the team 150 points.
