- Manage multiple ongoing and semester-based tasks and projects while being able to provide information and campus services to students and library patrons daily.
- Utilize transformational and adaptive leadership skills as co-chair of the Library Diversity Council. Since taking on a leadership role, the Library Diversity Council has become significantly more prolific in the opportunities it provides to staff for development and growth in the areas of diversity, equity, inclusion, and accessibility. One such opportunity has been the Inclusive Interpersonal Skills Series, which was piloted in 2017 as the Deep Listening session.
- Mentoring an undergraduate Michigan Library Scholar for an upcoming Living Library event. Developed a flexible work plan with established deliverables and additional training opportunities with a final capstone project for July 2018.
- Developed a comprehensive information services training curriculum informed by *Reference and User Services (RUSA) Guidelines for Information Service Professionals* and radical empathy approaches in customer service. Training was distributed across the entire Operations department to over 90 employees in various areas.
- Adapted Qualtrics survey software to house first iteration of the online Operations Information Services training, which was delivered on schedule and distributed to approximately 90 full-time, temporary, and student staff in the UM Library Operations department. The second iteration of the online training was then migrated to Canvas CMS.
- Ensured that the online Operations Information Services training incorporated inclusive design principles such as different modes for varying learning styles, inclusive language, accessible text formatting, and providing diverse examples.
