In the process of starting to write everyone presents their first difficulties and facilities, for example, tiredness, many careless errors or even the lack of confidence.

When I started writing I remember that I was used to getting stuck all the time and I was unable to write anything about any topic. Because of this, I was unable to start writing my paper, much less finish it. Nowadays, I feel like as I research more it will help me to find an angle that I'm going to be interested in exploring, analyzing and discussing.

One difficulty that I have until today is the lack of inspiration. I tend to have problems finding ideas for my essays, and that's why I believe that portfolio idea that my teacher had is going to help me a lot with this process because it may help in identifying a problem early on and developing effective strategies for me.

Facilities are very easy to explore. I feel like I know the basics of grammar, and I tend to revise my texts a lot, and I have done that since I was younger because I was very insecure, and I kept revising for so long and editing things out.

It's important to remember that **many** children, adolescents and adults make mistakes or experience problems as part of the process of becoming better writers.
