

Shine a Light



The boardroom doesn't have to be a drab grey or white to be an effective and interesting meeting place. Rather than add color by painting stripes on the walls, take a cue from your old pal the triangle. To give your conference room some modern flair, take one corner and paint part of the wall a complimentary color, essentially painting from the top corner to form a large triangle. This breaks up the monotony of a single color and provides the eyes some upward movement focusing the meeting on you instead of the boardroom table.

A Little Dab Will do Ya

Thinking back on bold colors. To coordinate the rest of the room's décor, try stippling some matching colors from your curtains, tapestries, or other colorful accents. Take two to three colors and randomly paint either over the entire wall (https://www.limitlesswalls.com/wall-murals.html) or up to two-thirds of the wall, leaving the top third a bright neutral color giving the illusion of more space and light. Add some coordinating pillows or pillow shams, depending on the room used to complete the look.

Frame That Mural
