Artsy Treatment

A newer trend in decorating, the triptych-style layout is perfect to have a contemporary and clever look to your bedroom. Take one of our gorgeous skyline murals (https://www.limitlesswalls.com/wall-murals/rooms/residential/bedroom.html) and apply to 3 canvas panels to give your bedroom a dramatic and artistic accent wall. With the right dramatic photo, your walls won't need any more additions to make a bold statement.

Wooden Trim

Another inexpensive yet elegant treatment for your bedroom walls is crown molding. Pay attention to your wallpaper or wall mural design to give you inspiration for what type of trim to use. Create a frame or set of frames (remember triptych?) and paint them a white or bright color to add emphasis to a painted wall, or

frame special parts of your wall mural. You could also take a piece of fabric or wallpaper and apply to that wall. Then add your crown molding frames to give the illusion of framed artwork.

Or go a step further an add wooden appliques inside the crown molding frames. This just further adds a dash of class to your bedroom décor. If you want to completely indulge in wooden accents, add some wooden corbels as the top edges of your accent wall to add a touch of finesse to your bedroom (https://www.limitlesswalls.com/wall-murals/rooms/residential/bedroom.html).

Painting is Not Just for Picasso

Decorative painting techniques can also give some life to a plain painted wall or help tie together your wall mural (https://www.limitlesswalls.com/wall-murals/rooms/residential/bedroom.html). Take our skyline (https://www.limitlesswalls.com/wall-murals/collections/city-skyline/new-york-city.html)picture again. If you have a nighttime or dusk wall mural, try stenciling blocks of squares in complementary colors to give the illusion of additional buildings at night. You don't have to be an artist to use stencils; just a steady hand and the desire to create.

Or take that painted accent wall and distress it with some finer grit sandpaper on the edges or where it would look like natural wear and tear could occur. This distressed look gives some warmth and a lived-n look to make your bedroom cozy.

There are several easy ways to add texture and depth to your bedroom walls. Sponging can be done by either applying several layers of paint giving your walls a subtle pattern of color, or for more contrast use 2 or more colors in sponging. Ragging or rag-rolling gives your walls a completely different texture by pressing a dampened, crumpled cloth across the wall. Rag-rolling is similar but instead of randomly crumpling your cloth, roll it into a tube shape then roll it along the surface of your wall. Stippling is yet another way to add subtle color and texture by using a special stippling brush and pressing it into the wall. With all of these techniques, you will need to rinse your chosen applicator often to achieve the best pattern and texture.

Your Own Art Gallery


