

WHERE TO GET A WORLD MAP WALL PRINT | LIMITLESS WALLS

For those on a shoestring budget or just love doing arts and crafts type of projects, you could try one of the many ways to source out some images. Some places to look:

- Old road maps collecting dust in your garage.

You may not have an entire world globe, but you can still use it as a source of inspiration.

- Old world globes.

With some steady hands and a utility knife, you can cut the globe into pieces and reassemble with some creativity.

- The internet.



There are tons of free graphics and images if you know where to look. Just use something like Google's image search to find the right look. Then either print from home or see if your local printers will make something for you.

- **Magazines.**

Make a modern looking map by either cutting images out of magazines, or simply cut the shapes of continents or countries and make your own unique looking world map.

- **Posters.**

There are tons of posters that you can buy either on the internet or a local shop. You might even be able to find some in a thrift store or yard sale. Try decoupage or create a patchwork design on your walls.

- **Artwork.**

Again, if you are lucky, you might find some inexpensive or worn out artwork that you could take and create some unique maps from. Or even luckier, find some old geography class maps to decorate your walls.



Each of these sources would use a technique called decoupage. Decoupage is the art of creating collages out of random paper onto a surface.

How to Decoupage

1. First you'll want to make sure that your wall or surface is clean and dry. (It may be a good idea to put a primer coat of paint to give you a good start to your project.)
2. Take pieces of paper whether they are from wrapping paper, wallpaper scraps, magazine cutouts, old maps, or even printouts from your computer and either cut or tear into shapes. These shapes can be geometric shapes or randomly formed. Don't be afraid to let your imagination and artistic flair decide.
3. Apply a thin coat of white glue (Use 50% glue and 50% water for easiest application.) onto the backs and then place onto your wall or other objects. The key to decoupage is to do some random overlapping of shapes.
4. It's important to make sure to give your wall at least 24 hours to dry between coats.
5. Once you have your wall or other object covered, apply another thin coat of white glue over the surface.

6. Depending on the surface you may want to sand and seal the decoupage with varnish or other sealant. (ensure that walls are completely dry before proceeding.)

Perhaps this sounds like too much work, or you just don't feel like you have much of an arts and crafts knack.
