



Legislature Passes Bill Expanding CNA Role

On June 16, 2023, Florida Senate Bill 558 was signed into law, authorizing nursing home facilities to allow registered nurses to delegate certain tasks, such as medication administration, to certified nursing assistants.

In other words, CNAs working in nursing homes can hold the designation of Qualified Medication Technician after completing an additional 34-hour training course approved by the Board of Nursing. This additional role requires the supervision of an RN. While CNAs are not required to take on these responsibilities, this new rule expands the opportunities available to them.
