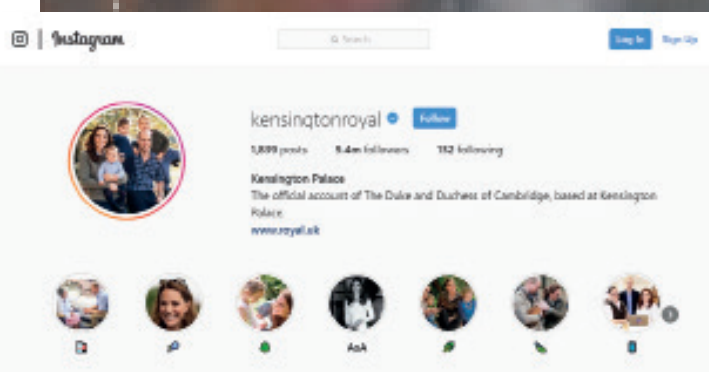
Since returning from her last maternity leave, several months ago, Kate has been throwing herself into Royal duties. Insiders say both she and William are now ready to get serious about the future and what lies ahead, with a powerful 11-point plan.

1 UPPING HER TRAINING

Over the last few months, Kate is said to have been spending more one-on-one time with the Queen than previously. In these meetings, insiders explain that Kate and her grandmother-in-law talk about what's expected of Kate as the future Queen Consort. In fact, according to Royal experts, since the Queen has taken her "under her wing" to discuss exactly what the position entails, Kate appears to take every word she says very seriously and makes notes on everything. Currently the account has 9.5 million followers and updates regularly. 3 UNIVERSAL APPEAL

The Cambridges, now more than ever, understand how important it is to appeal to as many people in the UK, and the world, as possible. This could be why William is being very clear about his and Kate's unprejudiced views. When asked recently how he would react if any of his children were gay, he replied, "You don't really start thinking about that until you are a parent, and I think – obviously, absolutely fine by me." This public statement is powerful, especially for the LGBTQ+ community.

4 CUTTING HER 'RURAL RIVAL'

One Royal story that has caused a lot of intrigue this year is the abrupt end to the Duchess's friendship with the Marchioness of Cholmondeley, Rose Hanbury (pictured right).

Rose lives with her husband in Norfolk, not far from one of Will and Kate's residences, and belongs to a social group nicknamed the 'Turnip Toffs' by the media.

Apparently Rose and Kate were close until something happened to cause Kate to suddenly distance herself from her friend, thus resulting in the pair becoming 'rural rivals'.

Rumours about the alleged tiff were rife in the Norfolk society set, and it wasn't long until the gossip inevitably made it to the papers with the word 'affair' alluded to on occasion.

This was, of course, all dismissed as nonsense, but it's said that Kate was not happy about the 'drama' and is keen to keep her social circle very small and private going forward.

5 SHOWING FOOTAGE OF HER KIDS

Over the years, Prince George and Princess Charlotte have been pictured at weddings and Royal events, but the only peek into their normal lives has been through the odd picture released by the couple, such as the children on their first day of nursery and school. 6 PLAYING TO HER SKILLS

7 SPLITTING THE ROYAL FOUNDATION

What was once The Royal Foundation, presided over by both the Sussexes and the Cambridges, is now simply The Royal Foundation of the Duke and Duchess of Cambridge.

It's not been revealed exactly what caused the division, though the Palace released a statement saying, "These changes are designed to best complement the work and responsibilities of Their Royal Highnesses as they prepare for their future roles, and to better align their charitable activity with their new households."

8 WINNING OVER THE QUEEN

Insiders commented that since the Queen is a Patron of the Chelsea Flower Show, it went some way to earning Kate some Brownie points with the Monarch.
