BEST ALL-ROUNDER FOUNDATION

IT'S NOT EASY TO FIND A FOUNDATION THAT WILL KEEP NEARLY EVERYONE HAPPY. From those with dry skin to oily skin, acne-prone to mature, and those looking for added sun protection, this foundation is as close as it gets to a universal crowd pleaser! One of the plus points is that it contains skin-perfecting ingredients, so the more you wear it, the more these can get to work. Plus, the coverage is great and your skin doesn't feel caked in make-up. And, although claims that it lasts a full 24 hours might be pushing it if you don't invest in the matching powder, you can get at least 10 hours out of one application, easy. It's also non-chemical, fragrance free, won't clog pores and has a good shade selection.

GREAT VALUE

As far as foundations under a tenner go, this one is hard to beat. It applies really well and because it's packed with hyaluronic acid, skin feels soft and a little more radiant. The colour technology also means that the shade range matches around 98% of skin tones worldwide – good news as many of L'Oréal's contemporaries have a woefully small shade range.

LIQUID BRONZER

The trick is to apply just two drops onto the tips of your fingers and then pat (don't rub) onto the skin, along the hairline, hollows of the cheekbones or anywhere for a hint of colour.

BEST PRIMER

PRIMERS HAVE A HARD JOB.

They have to fill pores, make foundation last longer, and give skin a smoother appearance, all while not taking away from natural radiance. There are a few decent ones available, but we found Photo Finish ticks the most boxes and works on the most skin types. We love how it blurs the appearance of imperfections instantly and feels like a dream on the skin.

BEST BLUSH

FAIR SKIN

This product by e.l.f not only stays put and doesn't accentuate pores, but is also a really beautiful shade on pale skin tones.

OK, STROBE CREAM ISN'T ACTUALLY CLASSED AS A HIGHLIGHTER.



BEST TARGETED TREATMENT


