What some people don't know is that WBCTC also offers several allied health training programs that prepare students to enter the health field, which is experiencing significant growth as healthcare practitioners place more of an emphasis on preventive care. Graduates can use their skills to land entry-level jobs in phlebotomy, medical billing, and other exciting careers.

Certified Nurse's Aide

Nurse aides perform the basic nursing functions that keep patients comfortable. These functions include helping people with basic hygiene tasks, ensuring the safety of patients in hospitals and nursing homes, assisting with exercise routines, and helping people find comfortable positions in their beds and wheelchairs. The CNA training program at WBCTC helps students learn the skills necessary for success in this field, and it also prepares students to take the nurse aide certification exam.

Medical Billing and Coding

If you don't want to work directly with patients, consider a career in medical billing and coding. The WBCTC training program emphasizes the importance of using Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes. Students also learn about the laws and ethical considerations that play a role in the medical billing and coding field. Program participants benefit from the opportunity to practice their coding skills before entering the workforce.

EKG Technician

WBCTC also offers an EKG technician training program, which prepares students to perform electrocardiograms in several medical settings. Electrocardiograms help identify problems with the heart's electrical system, so EKG technicians are important members of the healthcare profession. Students learn how to perform the EKG test and also prepare to take the national certification exam.

Pharmacy Technician

The pharmacy technician training program prepares students for careers in retail and hospital pharmacies. A pharmacy technician works under the supervision of a licensed pharmacist, preparing medications and assisting customers. The WBCTC program teaches students the skills they need to excel in a professional environment. Students also prepare to take the national pharmacy technician certification exam.
