


WHY BUY A PARKRIDGE GOLDENDOODLE?

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS

Our puppies' forever families are important to us, so we ask you to take the time to fill out our puppy purchase and selection application fully and carefully. Once the application is submitted, we will send you a link to set up a call with us. We want to get to know the people who purchase our precious pups so that we can match you well and care for you, just as we do our pups.



After our conversation, we will send you an invoice for your (non-refundable) deposit of \$400. Deposits are payable via cheque, e-transfer, or PayPal.



WHAT DOES ALL-INCLUSIVE MEAN FOR YOU?

At Parkridge you are receiving more than just a puppy, our package includes:

TRAINING

All of our puppies go through our Enriched Training and Socialization Program from birtheight weeks. This program was uniquely developed for Parkridge by our professional trainer Darcy Jennings. Darcy has years of experience working specifically with doodles. This has allowed her to tailor a program geared toward the Goldendoodle temperament. In addition Parkridge is proud to be the only professional and experienced Goldendoodle breeder in Canada to raise just one litter in a home at a time. Our Enriched Puppy Program Includes:



FULL TIME CARE

Caring for your puppy is our full time job. Your puppy will spend over a thousand hours in our care, which includes being available to nurture your puppy day and night.

SOCIALIZATION

Puppies have a narrow window of socialization from 3-12 weeks. We take special care to introduce your puppy to various sights and sounds in a positive way. This includes:

- Surfaces (ie pool noodles, pans, different flooring)
- Sounds (ie vacuum, loud toys, weather noises)
- People & Animals (ie Veterinarian, children, babies, elderly, cats, dogs, birds)
- Environments (ie rooms, car rides, drive thru)
- Grooming (regular baths followed by a blow dry and other grooming tools)



selection

From the moment you meet your puppy you will have the support of our professional trainer. Our trainer will guide your selection process by providing a temperament test. VETERINARY CARE

Your puppy will come to you with his/her first vaccines, deworming, veterinary exam & registered <u>microchip</u>.

We have been working with the team at Cobble Hill Animal Hospital in Cobble Hill, BC for over five years. Dr. Ian Keery is our primary veterinarian and can be reached at 250-743-4322. We recently extended our veterinary care to include Chase River Veterinary Hospital in Nanaimo, BC. They can be reached at 250-591-4050.

HEALTH TESTING

The health of our dogs is supremely important to us. We invest in breeding dogs from the best breeders in North America and Europe. Our dams are never bred before the age of two, and they have just one litter a year. All of our breeding dogs must pass a full range of health testing including for hips, heart, eyes, knees, thyroid, and blood disorders.

HEALTH WARRANTY

We stand behind the health of our puppies with a 3 year health warranty. What sets our warranty apart is that all serious genetic illnesses are covered (not just a few). We don't require you to return your puppy, and the length of our coverage is one year longer than standard.

P H O T O G R A P H Y

birth - eight weeks

At Parkridge Goldendoodles it's important to us that you feel connected to your puppy every step of the way. Imagine receiving puppy updates via email that include professional photos of this precious time in your puppy's life. We hire the best photographers on Vancouver Island to document your puppy's journey from birth to eight weeks

family photo session

Nothing is more exciting then announcing your newest addition to friends and family. Parkridge Goldendoodles helps you do this by providing a family photo session with your puppy on our Open house weekend. We will capture you with your Goldendoodle puppy.

for keeps

To save you the hassle we will sort through all the photos to save just the pictures of your chosen puppy. These photos along with your family photo will be stored on a USB for you to keep.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

WHERE IS MY PUPPY RAISED, AND IS S/HE PROPERLY SOCIALIZED?

We raise our puppies in the centre of our homes. We believe that puppies cannot receive proper socialization and care if there is more than one litter being raised in a home at a time. It is our goal for our puppies to be at the centre of the family experience so that they can easily transition into your family. We follow an enriched socialization program created exclusively for Parkridge Goldendoodles by our professional trainer.

HOW DOES PUPPY SELECTION WORK?

We consider each family's specific needs and preferences and work with you to select a puppy at the seven-week Open House. Since our puppies are raised in our home, we get to know their personalities and preferences well, aiding us as we make recommendations for homing each puppy. In addition, we provide professional temperament testing at seven weeks, allowing us to assess a puppy's individual needs. Selections are made in order of reservations. We keep all families in mind when recommending a puppy for you.

WHEN CAN I VISIT MY PUPPY?

On the Saturday nearest your puppy's seventh week, we invite you to an Open House where you will visit with, and spend one hour of family time (including selection) with, your puppy. We invite you to attend a one-hour training session with your puppy on the following day to learn everything you need to know about taking your new puppy home. A professional family photo with your puppy will be taken prior to the puppy training session. Due to the effort necessary to prepare for this weekend, and because our puppies are not vaccinated until they are seven weeks old, we are not able to take visitors prior to this date. The following weekend, once your puppy is eight weeks old, s/he will be ready to go home.

ARE GOLDENDOODLES HYPO-ALLERGENIC?

Allergies are typically caused by dander and shedding. Goldendoodles that are more poodle than golden retriever will be better for those with allergies. This is because poodles shed very little hair or dander. We do not guarantee our dogs as hypo-allergenic, but individuals with allergies have adopted our F1b Goldendoodles (a Goldendoodle bred with a poodle) without any problems

CAN YOU HOLD ONTO MY PUPPY LONGER?

We want our families to make their puppies a priority. We let you know the date your puppy will be coming home two months in advance. There is a narrow window of socialization for puppies, and eight weeks is the optimal time for your puppy to transition into his/her new environment. We do, however, understand that things may come up, so if you need us to board your puppy longer there is a fee of \$50 per day for the first week and \$100 per day thereafter. Puppies staying with us longer must be picked up from our home. Delivery by air is available in some instances (shipping fees apply).

WHAT SHOULD I PURCHASE FOR MY PUPPY?

It is our priority to take excellent care of you and your puppy throughout the Parkridge Goldendoodle experience. We understand the frustration of trying to find the right products in a sea of items at the big box stores. We have carefully curated a package of locally-made, top-quality puppy essentials. These items are included with your puppy purchase.

WHAT IS THE COST?

The cost of your puppy is \$4750, all-inclusive. We stand behind our price as we hold ourselves to a high standard regarding not only the puppies, but the entire breeding process for the first eight weeks as we care for, raise, and usher these pups into the world. We believe in offering you an experience your family will trust, and a puppy you will love.
