So here are some of the best options for you to decide on.

1. Sony HT-A7000

When one talks about the best TV sound systems one of the first brands that come to mind is Sony. With Sony's virtual sound system technology, you can place this speaker vertically. Thus, there would be no need for a ceiling-mounted loudspeaker to have a 3D sound experience.

There is a room-filling acoustic thanks to two up-firing speakers for upcoming sounds, two beamers tweeter for a wide surround sound, five front speakers, and also a subwoofer for deeper bass.

Sony HT-A7000 includes Dolby Atmos, DTS:X, LPCM, hi-res wireless, and Sony 360 Reality Audio in the terms of supported audio forms.

With acoustic center synchronization, you have the ability to hear the sounds exactly from where the characters are standing.

2. Sonos Beam Gen 2

In 2018 produced sound system Sonos Beam Gen 2 by Sonos with the added features in 2021 is now more powerful. Dolby Atmos 3D sound standard is allowed to be supported. Its newer port HDMI eARC allows it to have wider bandwidth and lossless audio formats.

It comes with a white color option and with a compact size, which is perfect for you if you want a small sound system with the best audio. It is just over half wide and less than 10 cm tall, which makes it sit under most TVs. Despite its small figure, the sound quality is excellent.

There are few connection options available spaces in its back such as the HDMI port and an Ethernet port, but there is no optical port.

3. Vizio V21

It is more of a budget-friendly option for sound systems. It is only \$150 at Target stores and \$190 at Amazon. Vizio V21 is basic black with a lightly textured and plastic part on top. The control buttons are also displayed on the speaker of the top.

One of the best features is voice activation which comes with Vizio V21. For the voice assistant speaker, a whole new 3.5 mm connection port on the speaker.

After you connect the speaker to this port, the speaker automatically switches to the input, and all you have to do is to give a command.

4. Sonos Arc

Sonos Arc is the 11 Class D digital ampilificator that is perfectly aranged to the acoustic architecture. The sounds come out just like the original vocal frequencies with its eight elliptical woofers and the rich bass range. Due to Sonos Arc's far-range microphone array, developed beaming and multi-channel echo canceller it is easy to activate your voice assistant speaker. If you have a device powered by the iOS mobile operating system you can use Sonic Arc's software "Trueplay", which adapts the soundbar dynamically according to the room's matchless acoustic. There is a feature called "Night Sound" that reduces the loud noise effects.

5.Bluesound Pulse Soundbar Plus

Pulse Soundbar Plus by Bluesound is supported by Dolby Atmos' mesmerizing sound, which will make you feel like you are right in the middle of the action or of the recording studio on your TV. 24-bit sound processing, audiophile-quality drivers, and 120 Watt power in total make the Bluesound Pulse Soundbar Plus the center of your house. With this soundbar, it is possible to connect almost every sound device to itself with wired, wireless, digital, and analog connection choices.

It has the right format to fit under your HD TV, and it is designed for giving the best and most engrossing sound experience.

6.Bowers & Wilkins Panorama 3

In 2022 released Bowers & Wilkins Panorama 3 is a standalone bar supported by the Dolby Atmos and arranged with thirteen individual drivers in a 3.1.2 setup. It has an all-black design with mesh-style plastic, slightly small holes, tight fabric that wraps around and the side of the device, and at the top of the sound system. The back and the bottom are also made of solid plastic. It is made to be easily used. Therefore, it doesn't have a great number of extra settings or calibration modes.

Because of the wide size of the device, it doesn't fit between the 55" TV stand's legs, which might be a serious downside.
