






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


Centralization









Container Tracking

Shippabo enables users to build Custom Views that automatically track the last free days for their containers. These views can be turned into reports that and sent out to your network so everyone is kept in the loop.


Knowing when free days will expire allows teams to pre-plan how they're going to move their containers from port to delivery and back.
