

ELA lesson plan 2023

Title of Lesson: Heart word egg hunt

Date of Lesson: 3/28

Learning Goals:

- Students will use their awareness to be able to find 2 eggs
- students will be able to identify the heart word in their egg
- students will help their peers if they do not know their word.

Learning Objectives (of the lesson):

- students will find eggs around the room with heart words in them. They will then try their best to tell the class what the word is by looking at it and sounding it out.
- If students know a word that their peer does not they will raise their hand to help.

Materials & Equipment Needed:

- The book "The great Eggscape"
- plastic eggs
- list of the classes "heart words"
- printed out heart words
- egg carton
- filled eggs

Introduction:

Students will listen to the book "the Great Eggscape" and then I will show them an empty egg carton and ask for their help to find the eggs.

Procedures:

- Students will listen to me read the book "The Great Eggscape"
- Pull out an empty egg carton and explain that the eggs have gotten out
- Ask them to go around the room and find two eggs
- once they find their eggs they will sit on the outside edge of the carpet and we will go in a circle opening our eggs and saying what heart word we have
- Students will be paying attention to what words their friends have and ready to help them if needed
- If a student does not know a word they can "phone" the first friend they see raising their hand
- once the student successfully says or repeats their word they will get a decorated egg in return.

Evaluation/Assessment: I will watch the students try their best to say their heart word and I will also see what words they do and don't know by how easily they can tell me the word.

ELA Lesson Plan 2024

Title of Lesson: Shamrock letter sorting

Date of Lesson: _____

Learning Goals:

- students will recognize the letter on their card
- students will be able to name the letter to me
- students will be able to match the letter they see on their card to the same letter on the paper in front of them

Learning Objectives (of the lesson):

- Students will be able to identify, and then match the letters on cards to the letters on their worksheet correctly.

Materials & Equipment Needed:

- cards with letters on them
- a sheet with a bunch of letters scrambled on it with St.Patrick's Day characters on it
- Gold Coins

Introduction:

- explain to them that we are going to play a game and work on our ABCs. Then model the game for them and have them answer questions like "What letter is this" so they understand.

Procedures:

- take a card out of the pile
- read the letter out loud
- find the same letter on the sheet in front of them
- grab Gold Coin
- cover the letter with the Coin
- by the end, the paper should be fully covered with shamrocks

Evaluation/Assessment:

- I will see if they can name me the letter they see and then find the letter again.
