

SHORTCLIFFE SKATE PARK REVIEW

Located between The Link and Harvester in Loughborough, this skatepark is small but useful. The surrounding area was quiet, with no one else using the skate park and only a few dog walkers present in the park – it would be great to see more skaters using this area.



It features a half pipe, quarter pipe, ramps, and a railing. If you're a beginner skater, I would recommend this park to start out at as the ground is great for learning tricks and there's lots of ramps of different sizes to learn to drop in.

It's quite a small park and there isn't too much flat ground, although there are a few pathways which are okay to skate for practice. I did end up in the grass a few times. I was, however, very impressed with the artwork:

As it is such a secluded area, it may be best to wear a helmet and some padding if you can. The concrete is very solid, and the railings and ramps everywhere don't look very comfortable to my head. The remnants of vaping teenagers were still present on the ramps but overall, the site was clean.
