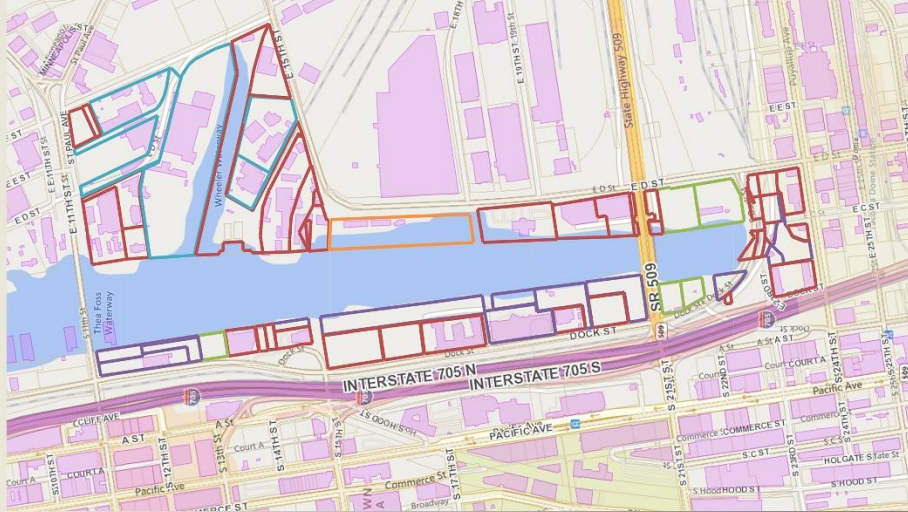

Saves the time for the workers



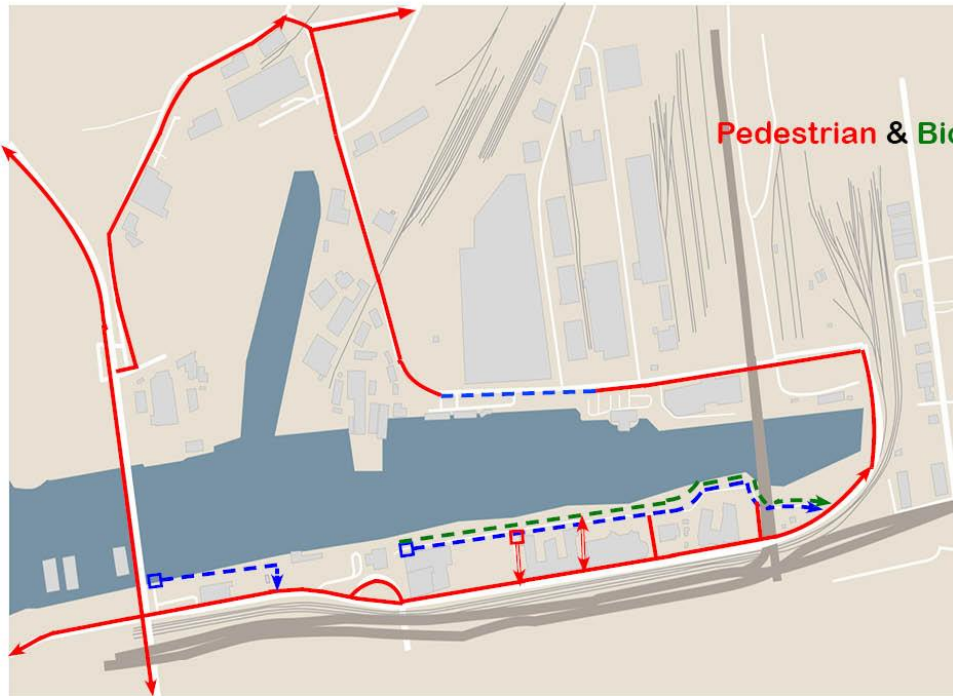

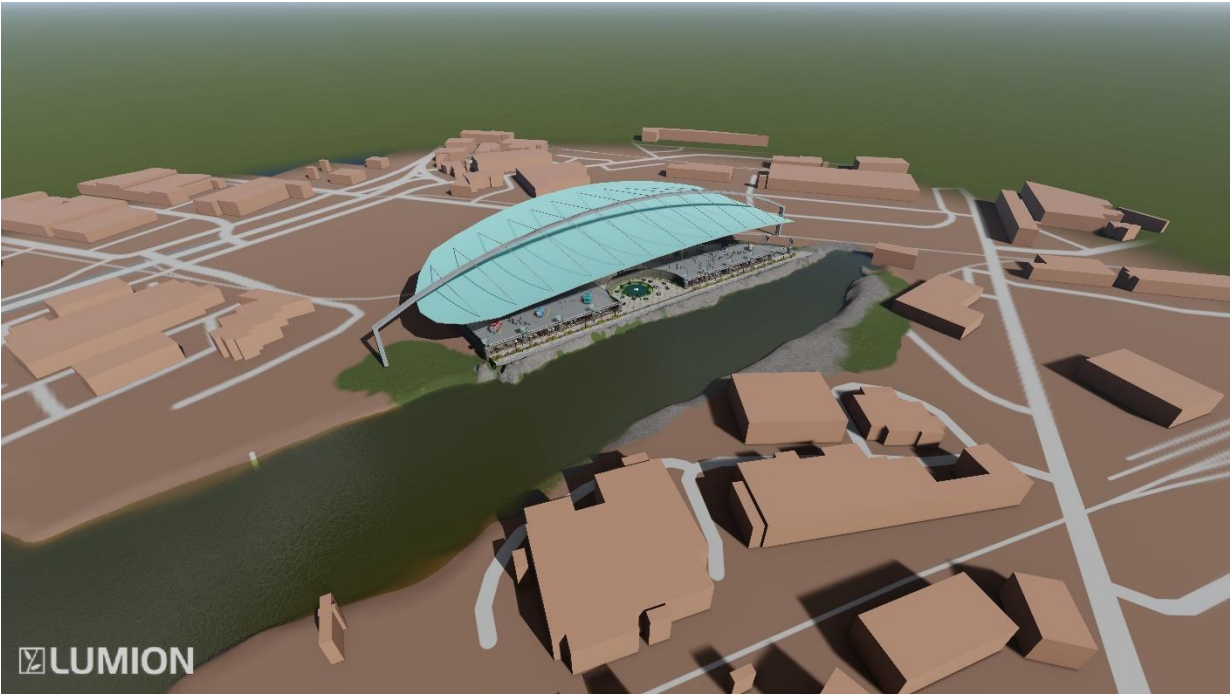
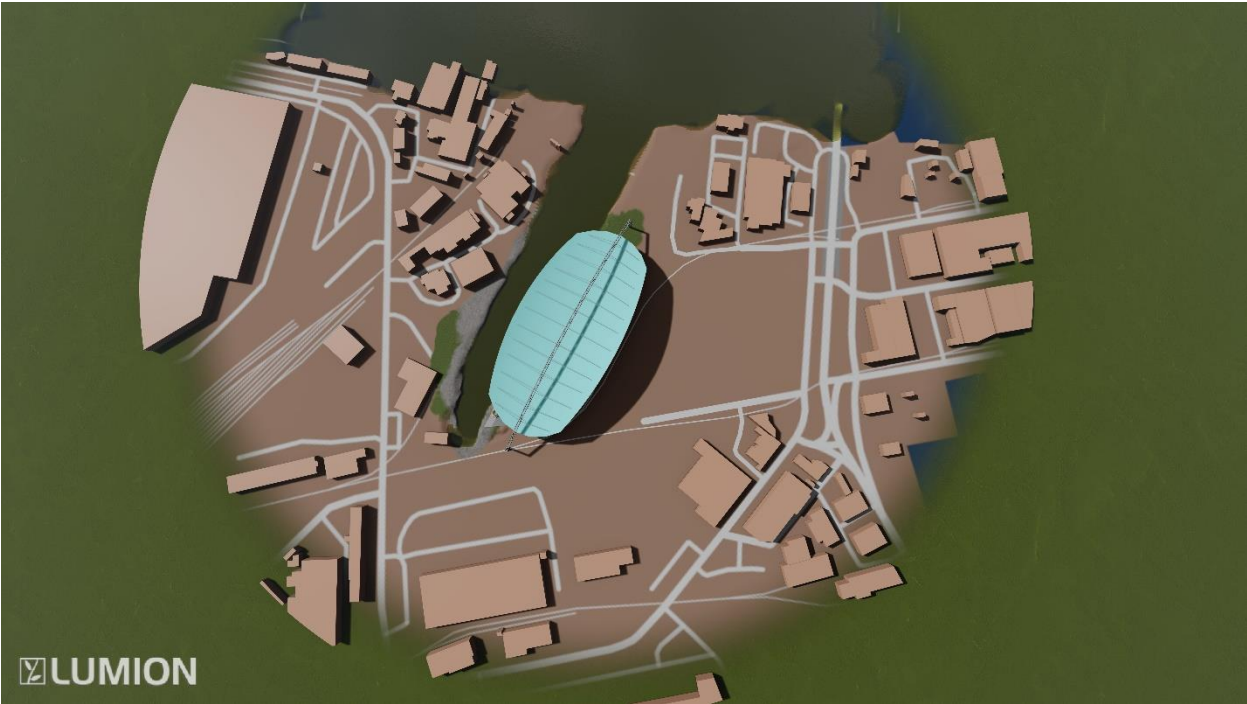
