Capturing the zeitgeist of party culture in the early 2000s with the hit single *Fit But You Know It* in April 2004, then tugging at everyone's heartstrings with break-up track *Dry Your Eyes* three months later, The Streets have become an institution in British music. Fronted by Birmingham-born rapper Mike Skinner, The Streets deliver storytelling like few others: honest, hilarious, and infectious. After countless performances, five albums and a six-year hiatus, the group finally dropped four much-anticipated new tracks at the end of 2017 and early 2018. But it's 2019 that fans have been waiting for. Not only are the band embarking on a European tour, but they've confirmed that a new album is imminent. On top of that, Skinner has also been working on a London-based film that he has described as both 'a Streets musical' and 'a farce about guys and girls getting into trouble'.
