Repair Karanda Hospital's water system so Zimbabweans can get critical medical care and hear the Gospel!

When most people in Zimbabwe need surgery, there's one place they'll go: Karanda Mission Hospital.

But right now, Karanda's in the midst of a water crisis. It needs your help to keep treating patients in need.

Will you help repair Karanda Hospital's water system? We need \$1,000 to buy a generator and electric pumps to repair the system.

Karanda is often Zimbabwe's only operational, public, surgical hospital. That makes it the only hospital many Zimbabweans can afford to go to for treatment. They walk days — even weeks — to get there.

It's not just that Karanda is affordable. Karanda's staff serve with a heart for Christ, and people feel the difference. They long for that difference in their own lives.

But Karanda's water system can't keep up with the hundreds of patients it sees every day.

Recent droughts left the hospital with only 12 hours of water a day!

"We have plans and backup plans, garbage cans dedicated for water only on each ward," says medical missionary Kiersten Hutchinson.

But a generator and pumps can help change all that. You can help provide clean water for mothers giving birth, cancer patients having tumors removed, people suffering from waterborne illnesses — and much more.

Plus, these patients will get to hear the Gospel from doctors, nurses and administrative staff!
