**Because you gave, TEAM was able to quickly send a Mercy Air helicopter with water filters and other survival supplies. And workers on the field got to buy a month's supply of food for affected families.**



You also provided malaria medication. And that's huge, Friend, because the risk of malaria always goes up after a storm like this. The standing water left by the storm creates massive breeding opportunities for mosquitoes. But the medication you provided will shield people from this deadly disease.
