What does CAD stand for?

Coronary artery disease (CAD) is when plaque builds up in the heart's vessels and makes them narrow. This can lead to blockages over time, which can cause chest pain or a heart attack.



Identifying The Signs

Some of the signs are pain in the chest, tiredness, shortness of breath, and pain in the arms or shoulders. If any of these things happen, call 911.



Figuring out what could go wrong

Know your risk - Obesity, idleness, a bad diet, smoking, high cholesterol, high blood pressure, diabetes, and a history of CAD in your family all raise your risk.



Coming up with a diagnosis

Doctors can tell if you have CAD based on your medical background, risk factors, and symptoms. There may be a need for tests like an ECG, a stress test, or a coronary angiogram



Choices for treatments

Treatments vary, but most of the time, lifestyle changes and medicines are used. There may be a need for angioplasty, bypass surgery, or stent placement.



How to Understand Stents

Stents keep the blood vessels open. There are two kinds: bare metal (for people with allergies) and drug-eluting (with a layer of the drug). Polymers on drug-eluting stents can last or break down over time.



Why are Stents used?

Re-narrowing is a usual problem after angioplasty that can be helped by stents. They can bend and fit the shape of your artery.



Different kinds of stents


Bare-Metal Stents are wire mesh tubes that don't have any drugs in them. Stents that release drugs are covered with a drug-releasing material. There are two kinds: lasting and biodegradable
