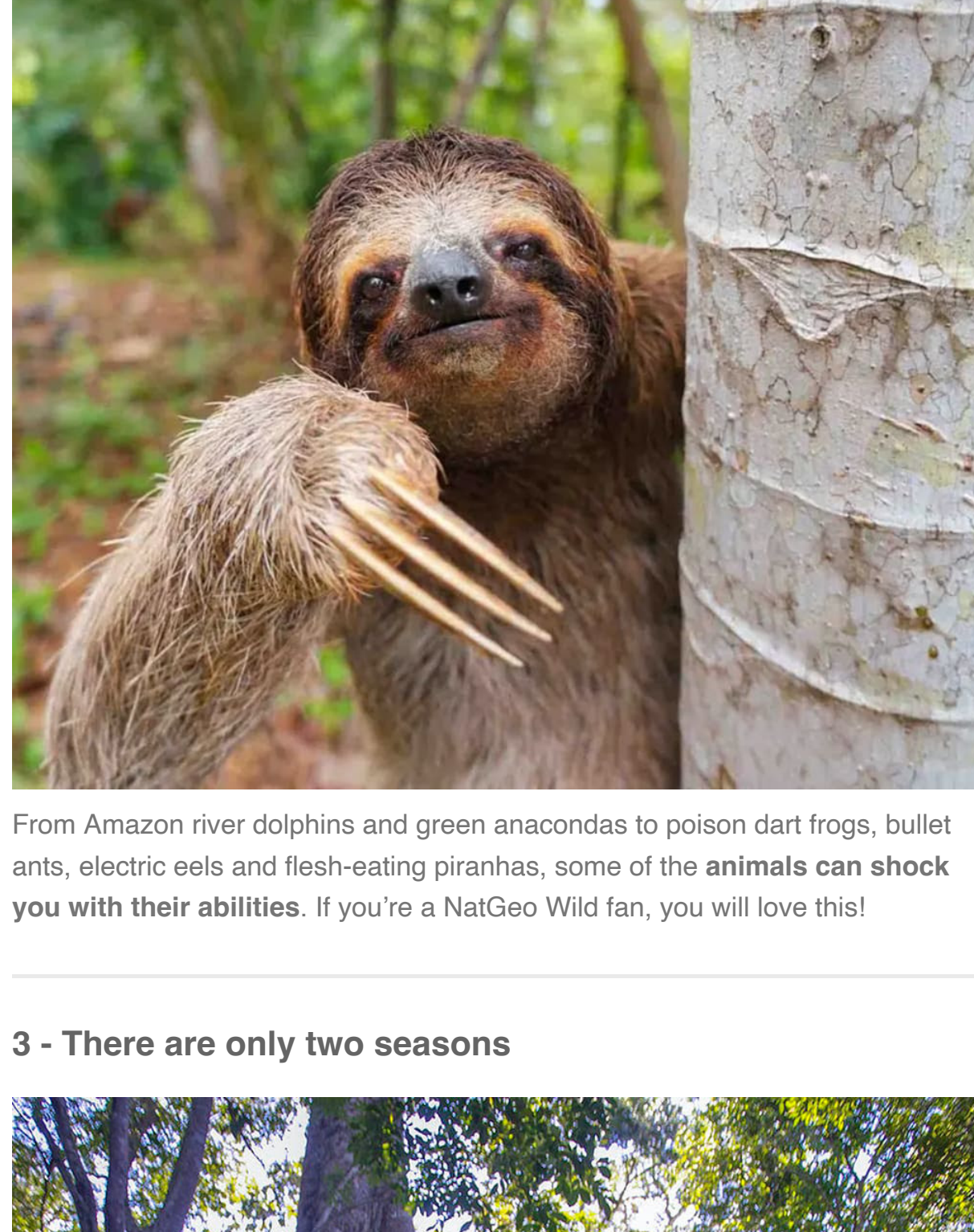

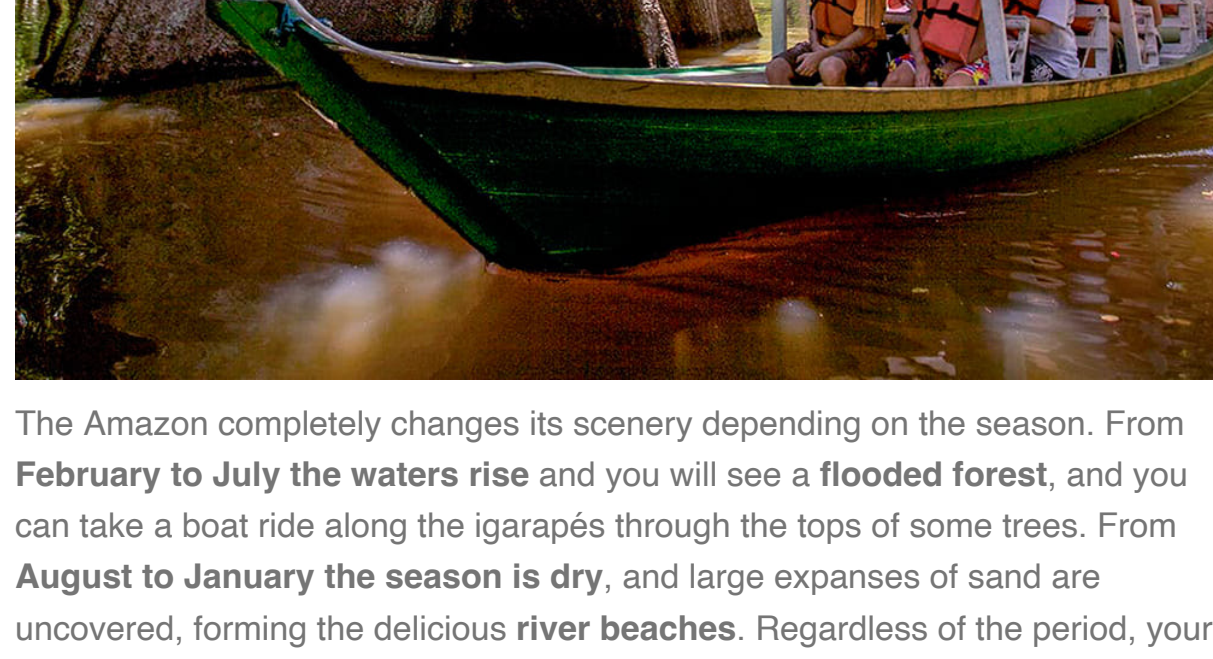
There is truly nowhere else in the world like there. While you decide which experience will plunge you into the depths of this rainforest, check out our awesome Amazon facts we separate for you.

## 1 - It's home to uncontacted tribes



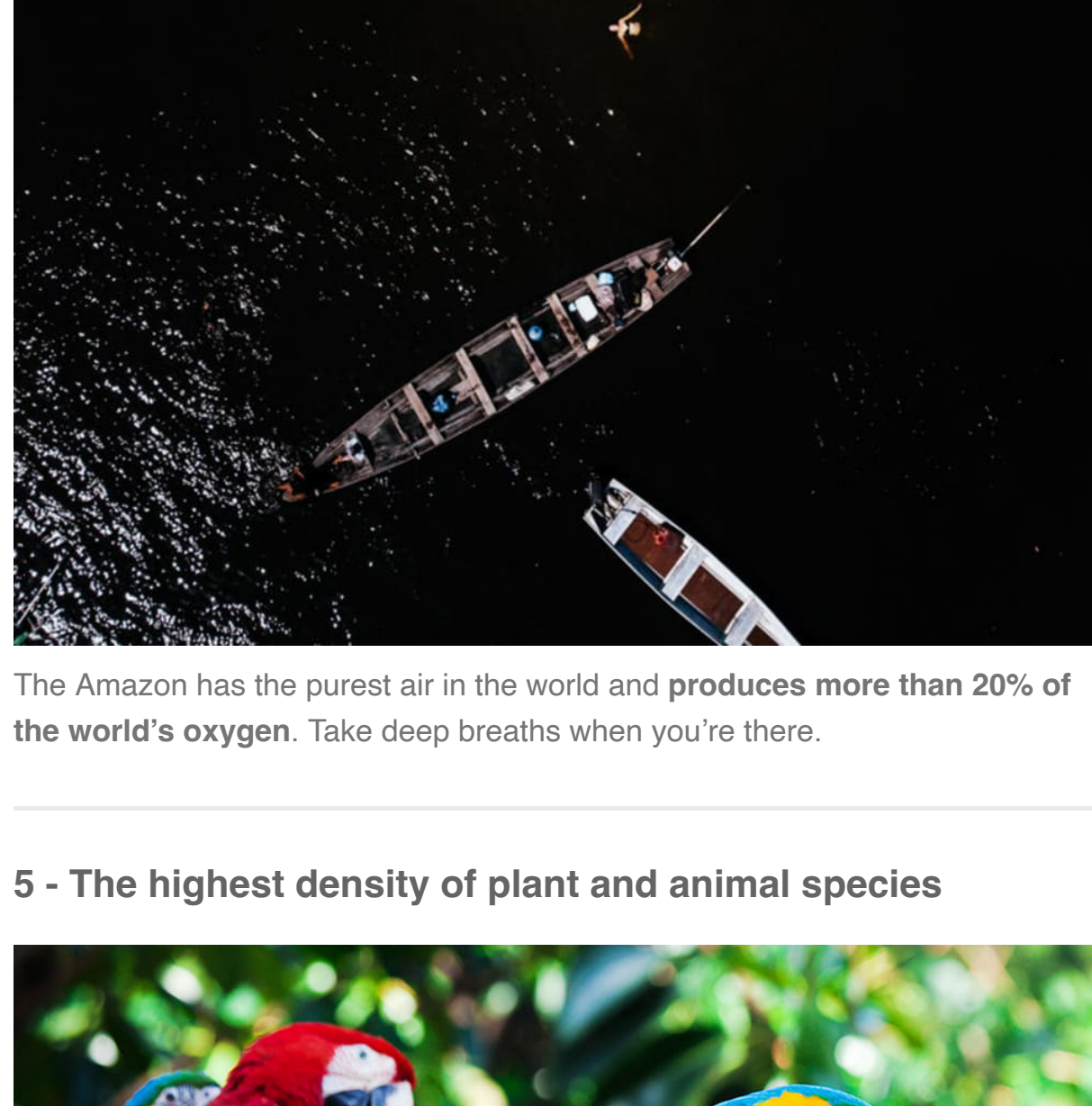
Around 400-500 indigenous Amerindian tribes call the Amazon rainforest home. It's believed that about fifty of these tribes have never had contact with the outside world! Have you ever imagined spending a few days without seeing anyone immersed in almost untouched places in the middle of 21?

## 2 - Extraordinary wild animals



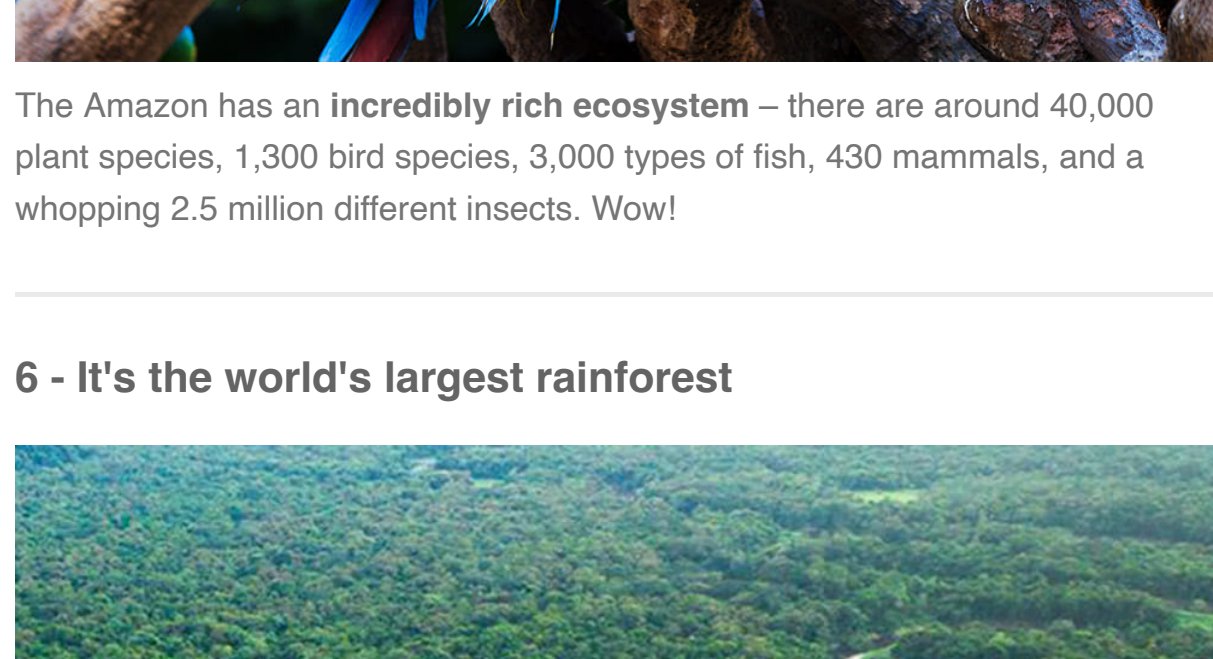

## 3 - There are only two seasons



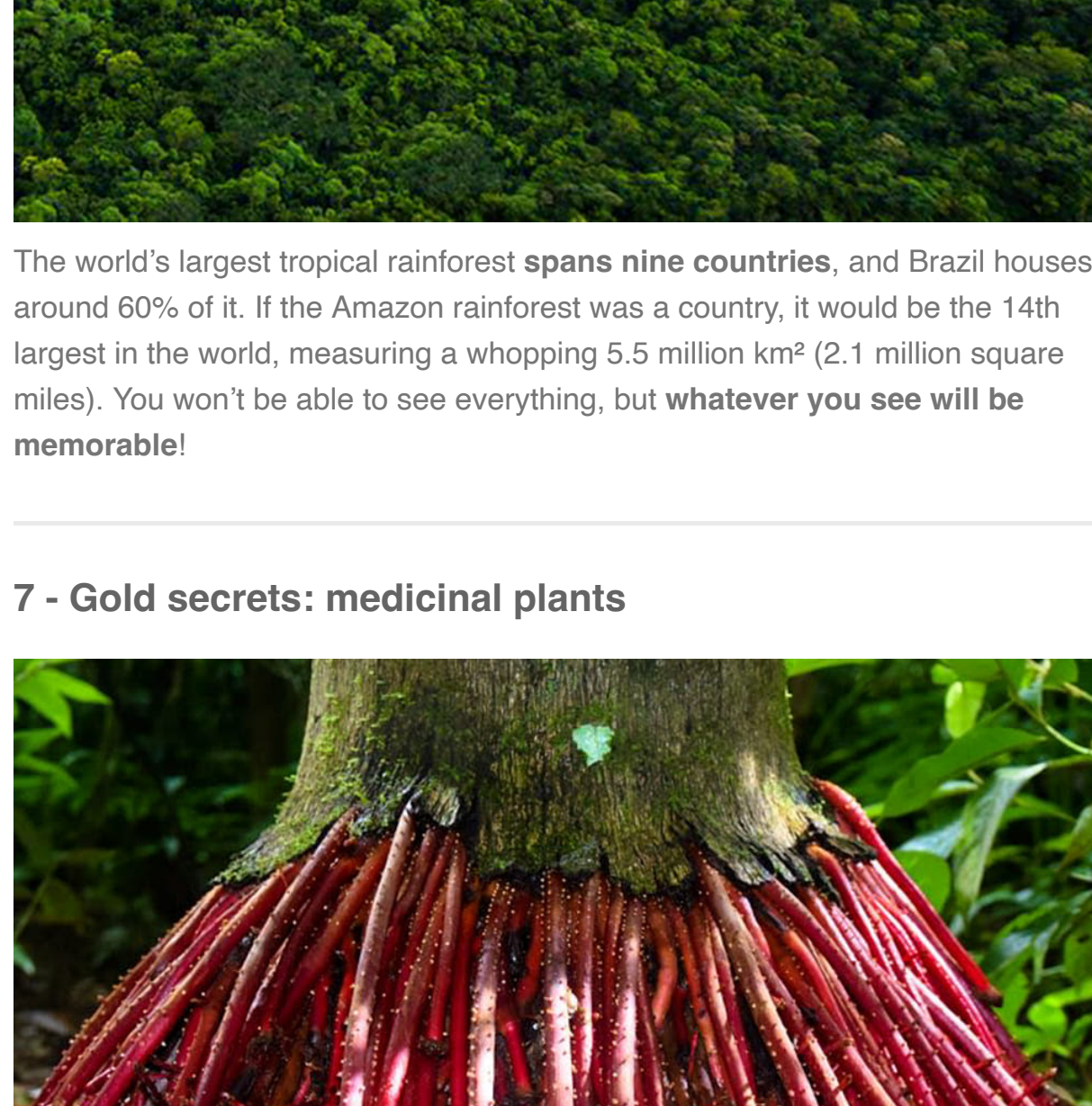
The Amazon completely changes its scenery depending on the season. From February to July the waters rise and you will see a flooded forest, and you can take a boat ride along the igarapés through the tops of some trees. From August to January the season is dry, and large expanses of sand are uncovered, forming the delicious river beaches. Regardless of the period, your experience will be amazing!

## 4 - The purest air in the world



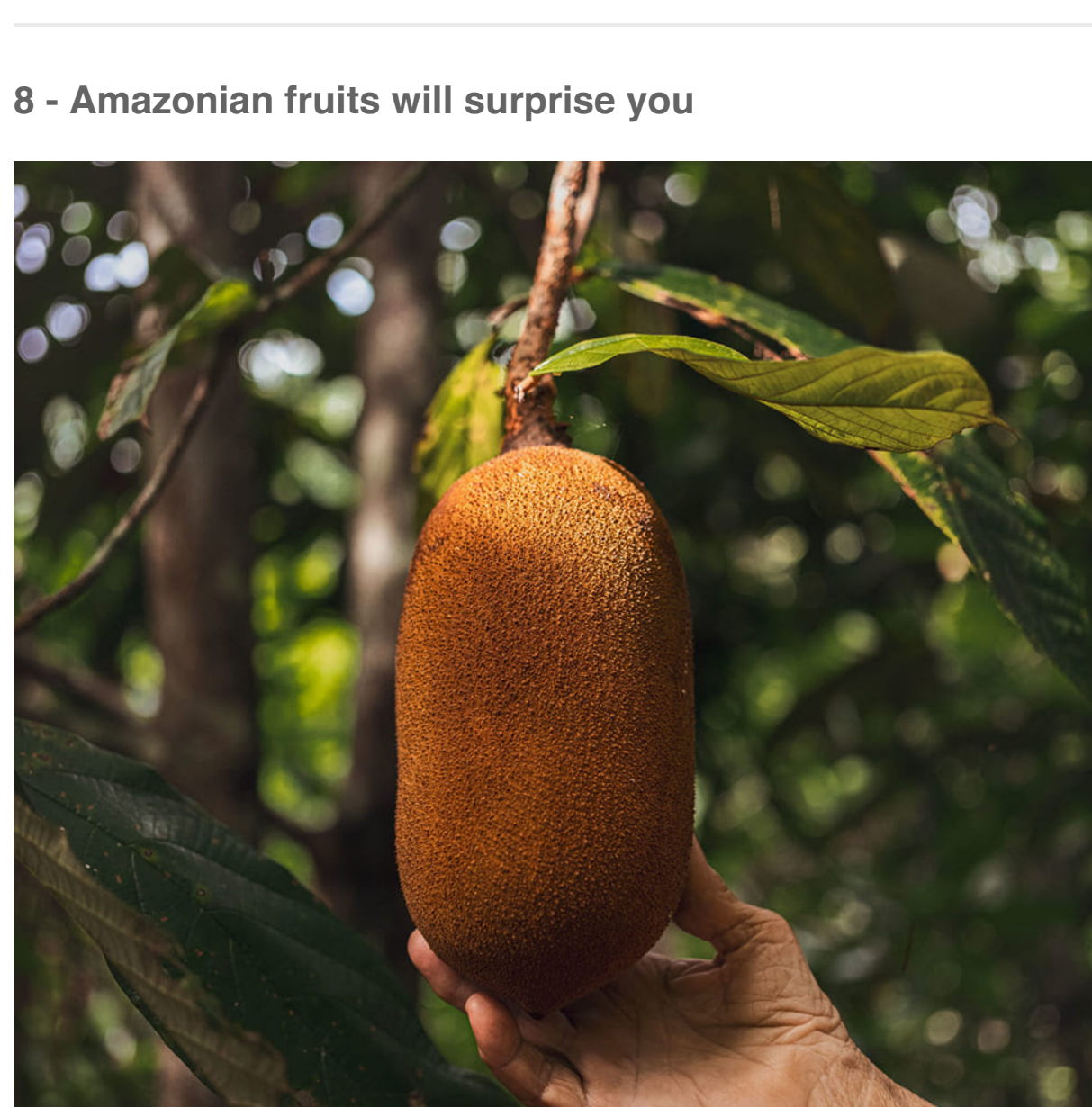
The Amazon has the purest air in the world and produces more than 20% of the world's oxygen. Take deep breaths when you're there.

## 5 - The highest density of plant and animal species



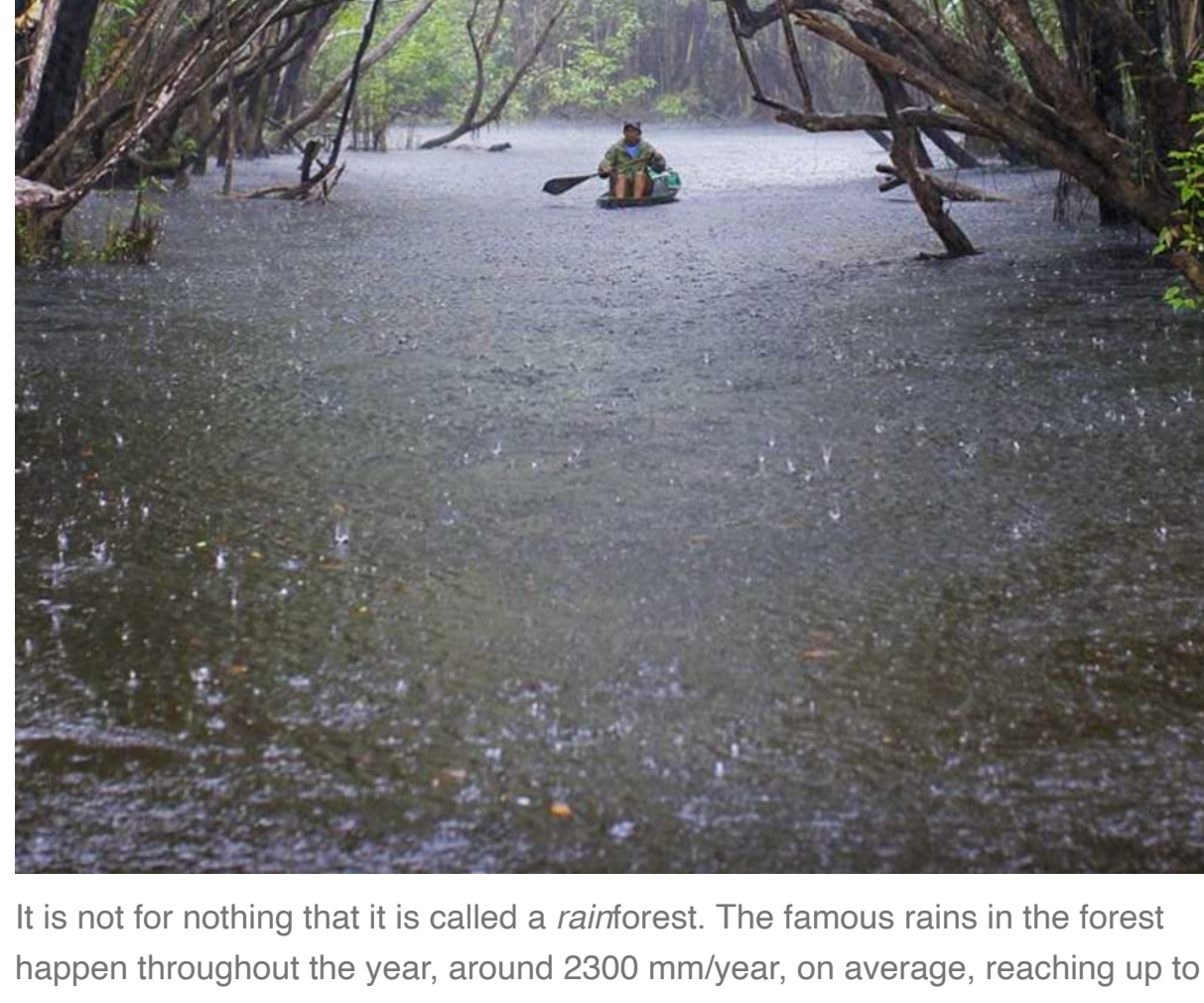
The Amazon has an incredibly rich ecosystem – there are around 40,000 plant species, 1,300 bird species, 3,000 types of fish, 430 mammals, and a whopping 2.5 million different insects. Wow!

## 6 - It's the world's largest rainforest



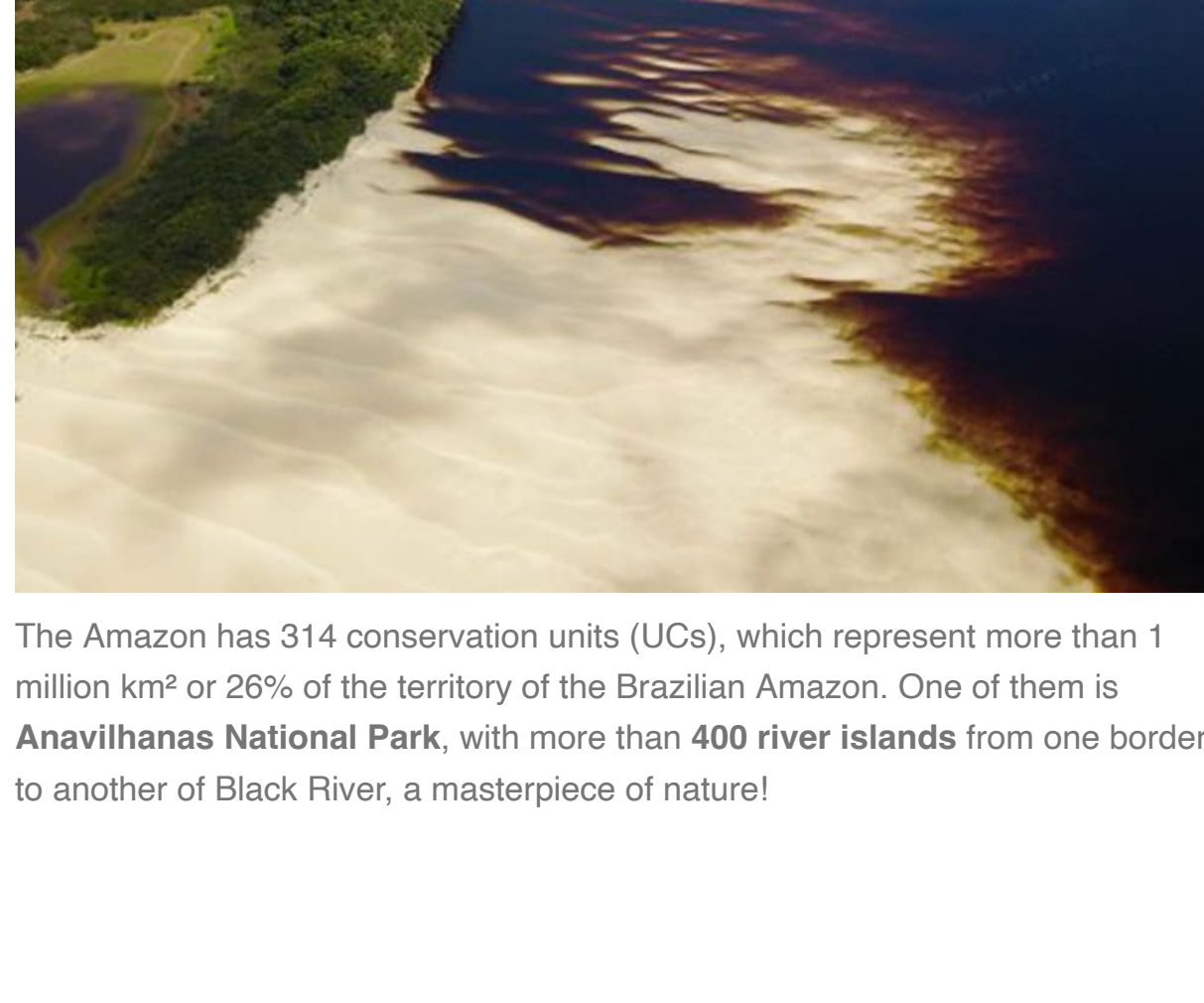
The world's largest tropical rainforest spans nine countries, and Brazil houses around 60% of it. If the Amazon were a country, it would be the 14th largest in the world, measuring a whopping 5.5 million km² (2.1 million square miles). You won't be able to see everything, but whatever you see will be memorable!

## 7 - Gold secrets: medicinal plants



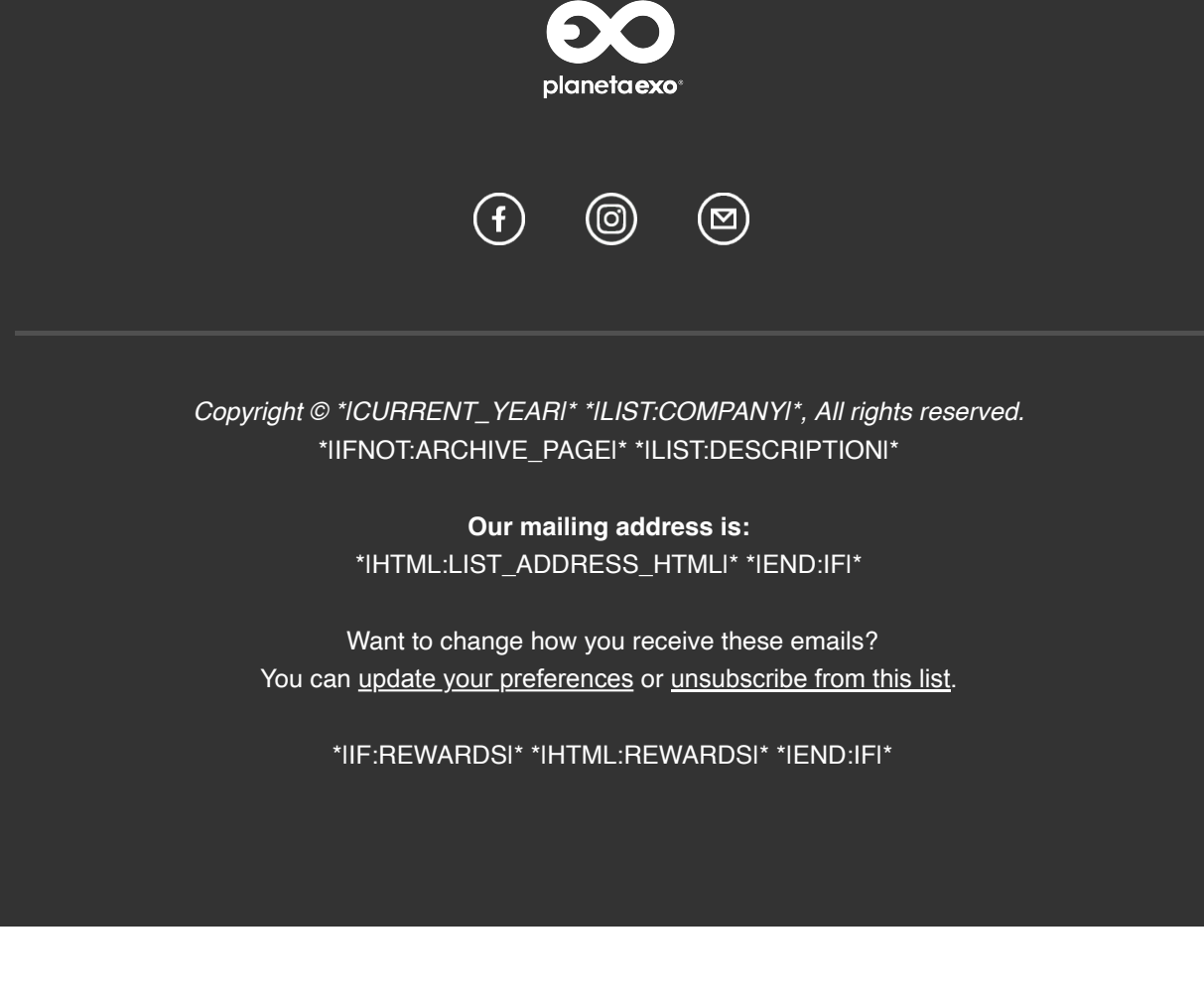
25% of all western pharmaceuticals come from rainforest-based ingredients, yet less than 1% of the trees and medicinal plants in the Amazon have ever been tested by scientists. Explore the forest and learn about plants for medicinal and aesthetic use.

## 8 - Amazonian fruits will surprise you



The origin of 80% of the varieties of food we get across the world origin in the Amazon rainforest. More than 3000 types of fruit which are grown in the Amazon are edible. There you will have the opportunity to try delicious fruits, difficult to find elsewhere, such as tucumã, cupuaçu and camu-camu (the richest fruit in vitamin c in the world).

## 9 - Trees make their own rain



It is not for nothing that it is called a rainforest. The famous rains in the forest happen throughout the year, around 2300 mm/year, on average, reaching up to 5000 mm/year. Researchers discovered that a part of those rains is produced by the own water vapor of the trees. You'll be grateful to have the opportunity to see nature in action and get wet with one.

## 10 - National parks are masterpieces of nature



The Amazon has 314 conservation units (UCs), which represent more than 1 million km² or 26% of the territory of the Brazilian Amazon. One of them is Anavilhanas National Park, with more than 400 river islands from one border to another of Black River, a masterpiece of nature!
