Perhaps that's why holiday light displays are so popular: They allow the viewer to steal a few moments of stillness within a season dominated by wish lists and task



1. Macy's Christmas **Light Show**

What: A Philadelphia holiday tradition since 1956, the Macy's Christmas Light Show weaves a holiday tale starring Frosty the Snowman, frolicking reindeer, dancing ballerinas, glittering snowflakes and seasonal music by the historic Wanamaker Grand Organ. More than 100,000 LED lights twinkle and glow against a four-story-tall velvet curtain that spans nearly the entire height of the department store's cavernous atrium.

2. A Longwood **Christmas**

What: Comprising 1,077 acres in Delaware County, Longwood Gardens is unsurpassed in terms of horticultural diversity in the Philadelphia region. But those visiting the gardens between late November and early January likely arrive

for a different reason: to marvel how Longwood Gardens seamlessly merges the beauty of nature with the magic of the holiday season.

A stroll through the massive greenhouse reveals thousands of poinsettias and lilies lining a manicure lawn, while outdoors, nearly 500,000 lights emit an ambient glow as they snake around leafless tree branches and illuminate water features from within.

3. Franklin Square Holiday Festival

What: Perched in the center of the historic Franklin Square Fountain, a larger-thanlife kite electrifies the night sky with more than 50,000 festive string lights. As you've probably already guessed, this high-wattage seasonal spectacle takes inspiration from Benjamin Franklin's famous kite experiment, but it also pulsates with the energy of visitors fulfilling a <u>family holiday tradition</u>.

4. Holiday Garden Railway

What: Crafted from natural materials such as twigs, moss and bark, a festive holiday town sets the scene for a miniature holiday railway at the Morris Arboretum, a beloved Philadelphia public garden. Toys in tow, the train follows an illuminated, quarter-mile-long

track across bubbling streams, through tunnels and under bridges.

If you wish to see the railway set aglow in all its holiday glory, be sure to purchase advance tickets for Friday Night Lights, a weekly event that occurs in December.


