Ashore | Places in Relief

Each arrival brings a distinct shift in atmosphere. Some destinations unveil themselves through humid rainforests and river communities where life remains closely connected to the water. Others come into focus through colorful harbor towns, open-air cafés and lively markets scented with coffee, tropical fruit and spice. Across the islands, local traditions continue to shape everything from architecture and cuisine to music and daily ritual.

On Board | Context in Motion

Between ports, the experience continues in quieter form. Culinary demonstrations, ingredient-led tastings, creative workshops and conversations with visiting experts bring texture to what lies ahead. Regional influences are explored as insights, offering ways to more deeply appreciate places through the traditions, creativity and cultural character that distinguish each destination.

Between Ports | The Rhythm of the Sea

Time at sea creates a satisfying continuity. It is where each experience settles, where distance becomes perspective and where the next arrival begins to take shape long before land is visible. These stretches are not interruption, but transition – an essential part of how the journey is experienced.

On each Oceania Cruises voyage, the experience is shaped as much by the journey itself as by the destinations along the way. Time at sea slows the rhythm of travel, creating space for anticipation, reflection and a deeper sense of connection to the region.

Seen this way, the Caribbean becomes less a sequence of ports than a continuous passage through distinct landscapes, cultures and traditions, each one surfacing gradually over the course of the voyage.

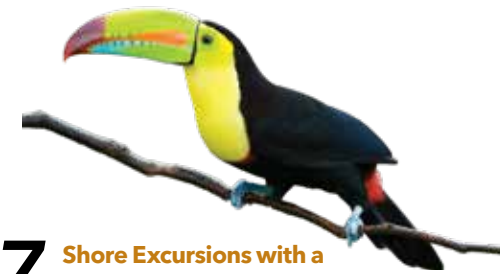

Eastern & Southern Caribbean



Basseterre, St. Kitts

Volcanic peaks rise beyond Basseterre, where rainforest trails, historic sugar estates and quiet shorelines reveal a relaxed side of the Caribbean. Inland, Brimstone Hill Fortress and Mount Liamuiga reflect the island's interwoven colonial and natural heritage.



St. John's, Antigua

Sailing yachts fill the harbor at St. John's, where winding coastal roads lead past sheltered bays, historic dockyards and beaches edged by calm turquoise water. At Nelson's Dockyard, restored Georgian-era buildings and quiet marinas recall Antigua's long-standing connection to the sea.



Bridgetown, Barbados

Along Bridgetown's palm-lined waterfront, colonial architecture, rum shops and open-air cafés reflect Barbados' distinct character. Beyond the capital, surf beaches, heritage estates and rum traditions remain embedded in life along the coast.



Fort-de-France, Martinique

French-Caribbean culture comes alive through spice markets, café terraces and lush gardens. Beyond the city, AOC rum distilleries, black-sand beaches and volcanic landscapes shape Martinique's distinctive character.

Western Caribbean & Central America



Cozumel, Mexico

Coral reefs and clear Caribbean waters frame Cozumel, where waterfront cafés, local markets and Maya heritage highlight the island's laid-back character. Along the eastern coast, rugged beaches and steady trade winds offer a wilder side of the Yucatán.



Harvest Caye, Belize

Rainforest, lagoons and coral reefs surround this biodiverse region, where wildlife habitats and Maya heritage thrive. Inland, spice farms, river communities and protected reserves connect travelers to Belize's natural landscapes.



Falmouth, Jamaica

Georgian-era buildings line the streets of Falmouth, where reggae drifts through open-air markets and lush mountain landscapes rise beyond the coast. Across the island, culinary traditions rooted in spice and wood smoke are woven into daily life, central to Jamaica's identity.



Panama City, Panama

Colonial streets and modern towers stand side by side in Panama City, where the movement of ships through the Panama Canal continues to define life between two oceans. In Casco Viejo, restored Spanish colonial architecture, seafood markets and rooftop cafés overlook the Pacific waterfront.

7 Days | Dec 7, 2026 | *Oceania Vista*

From the reef-lined waters of Mexico to the lush coastlines of Honduras and Belize, this journey through the Western Caribbean evolves at an easy, immersive pace. Mornings begin beside turquoise water and rainforest-flanked shores, while afternoons drift between Caribbean flavors, serene beaches and stretches of open sea.



DEC 7
Miami, Florida | Setting Sail

From open verandas and breezy decks, the Miami skyline begins to fade away. As the port softens into horizon, the first miles at sea seem to expand in slow motion – vast and full of anticipation.

DEC 8
Day at Sea | The Islands, Through Flavor

Before the first shoreline comes into view, the flavors of the Western Caribbean are revealed through hands-on cooking experiences at The Culinary Center. Spice-rubbed seafood, tropical fruit and slow-building heat offer an early introduction to the journey's coastal influences.

DEC 9
Cozumel, Mexico | The Ritual of Agave

In Cozumel, a chef-led tasting explores the layered traditions behind tequila and mezcal through small-batch pours paired with regional tacos. Local specialists share the stories, techniques and cultural rituals surrounding Mexico's most iconic agave spirits.

DEC 10
Roatán, Honduras | From Jungle to Mangrove Coast

DEC 11
Harvest Caye, Belize | Cacao, Story & Tradition

In the Belizean hinterlands, cacao comes alive through hands-on tradition and Maya Mountain community life. From stone-ground chocolate to village customs and forest botanicals, it offers a quiet window into enduring cultural practices.

DEC 12
Costa Maya, Mexico | The Language of Maíz

DEC 13

Miami, Florida | Arrival

After days among shifting tropical coastlines, rainforest canopy and the open sea's quiet, steady swell, Miami reappears ahead.

Ahead of shoreside explorations tomorrow, Guest Speakers offer deeper context for the islands ahead through conversations on Caribbean culture, marine life, architecture and the multifaceted histories carried from port to port.

Paddle through the protected waterways surrounding Cas Cay, where tangled red mangroves, tidal pools and shallow reefs introduce a quieter side of St. Thomas influenced by wildlife and sea life alike.

Philipsburg, St. Maarten | A Portrait of Caribbean Contrast

Gustavia, St. Barts | A Toast to French Elegance

Tortola, British Virgin Islands | Nature in Stone & Sea

DEC 19
Day at Sea | Sea-Level Calm
After days ashore, Aquamar Spa + Vitality Center offers a tranquil pause- aromatic steam rooms, restorative salt stone massages and open-air terraces overlooking the sea. Between islands, the horizon becomes part of the ritual.

DEC 20
Day at Sea | Studies in Light
At Artist Loft, the shifting coastlines, harbor light and island color palettes of your journey become inspiration for sketching, watercolor and photography sessions guided by talented Artists in Residence.

DEC 21
Miami, Florida | Arrival
After days spent moving among islands and open sea, Miami arrives again with memories of languid lunches, the scent of citrus blossom and the slower pace still lingering.



Panama Potpourri
MIAMI TO PANAMA CITY
10 Days | Jan 5, 2027 | *Oceania Marina*

Across ten days of coastal sailing, *Oceania Marina* moves from Mexico's coral-fringed waters through the rainforest edges and waterfront towns of Central America toward the Panama Canal. Villages and jungle-lined shores punctuate open-water crossings, tracing a route shaped by diverse tropical terrain and rich cultural traditions.



JAN 5

Miami, Florida | Setting Sail

The wake stretches behind the ship as the movement of the port softens into open water, carrying the voyage into the longer passages of the Caribbean.

JAN 6

Day at Sea | The Leisure of Lunch

With no port on the horizon, mornings and afternoons at The Grand Dining Room become an occasion for leisurely multi-course dining, where flavors and preparations subtly reflect the regions along the route.

JAN 7

Cozumel, Mexico | Painting by the Water

In a light-filled studio at Buccanos Beach Club, local artist Cari Barbachano guides an intimate painting session inspired by the sea. Wine and time by the water round out the afternoon.

Costa Maya, Mexico | Echoes of Kohunlich

Harvest Caye, Belize | Spice Trails of Belize
