With at least a nod to the world around them, the italian stallions have made sure to make their product both energy efficient and using ecologically natural gas. In short what this means is that there are zero greenhouse gases being emitted, leaving you a clear conscience as you chill. Well, relatively clean.

- LED Display Despite being known more for their classy espresso machines and retro-looking toasters, don't think that they can't design a simple but hi-tec display pattern on the top of the unit. Clearly and simply laying out the temperature, cooling mode, fan speed and timer, this means you can check at a glance what is currently going on, and programming it to give you the conditions you desire won't be like trying to programme the Death Star.
- REAL FEEL Technology You know the way the weather app on your smartphone shows the overall temperature, but then what it actually feels like, due to wind or something similar? Well this is the Italian manufacturer's own invention following that logic. It essentially combines the regular cooling attributes of the Pinguino AN112 with humidity control.
- Quiet Operation When you include the word "Silent" in your product name, you know you better deliver on your boast. Which is thankfully what De'Longhi do here, with the device featuring a maximum noise level of 50 db, so if you are using this as an portable office air conditioner, then you'll barely even register it's on.

Verdict

In case the overly dramatic open didn't make clear enough - global warming is not like Brexit. It is coming, whether we like it or not, the summers will keep on getting hotter, and not in a good way.
