Why a disaster plan ?

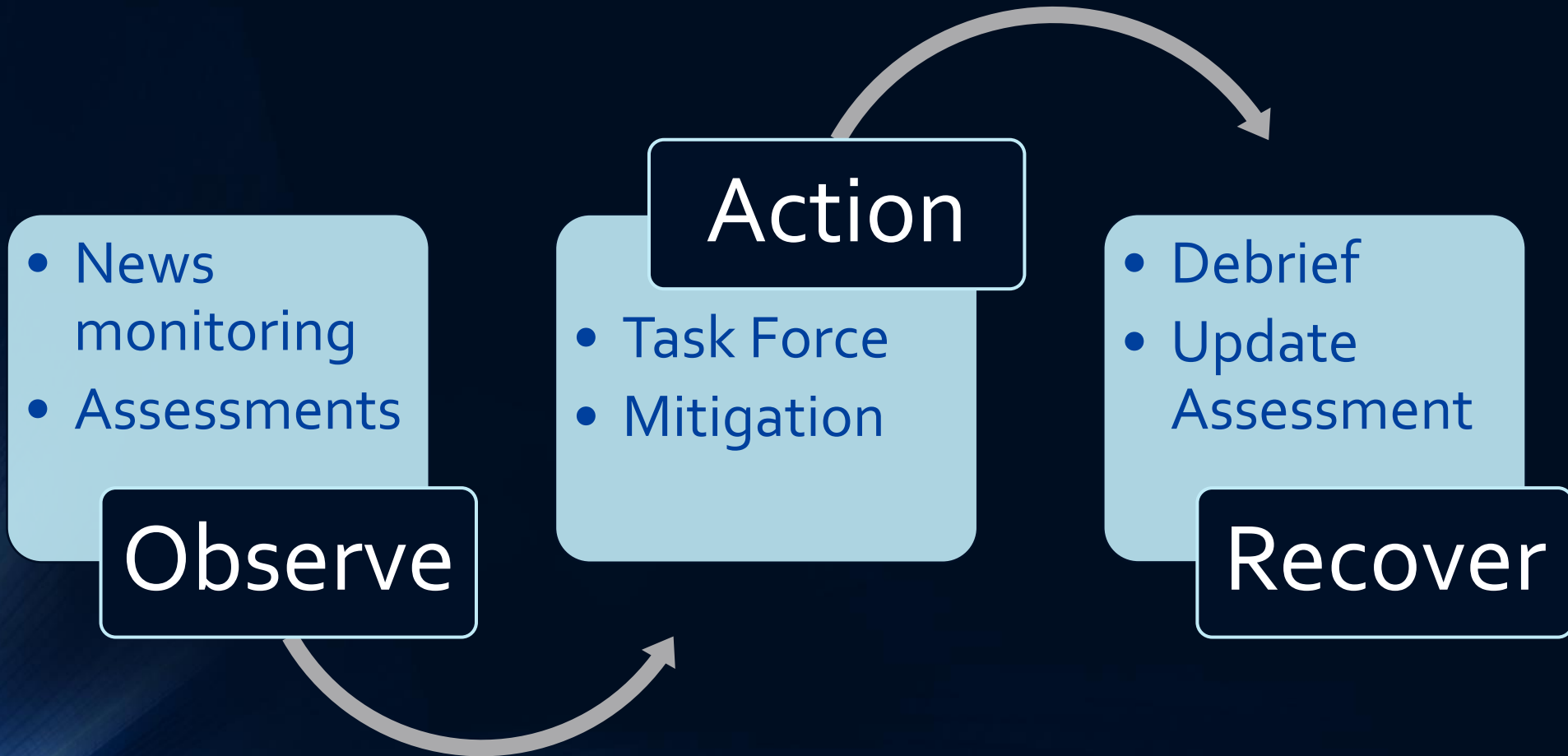
- Be able to continue “business as usual” without major disruptions
