


Rebecca Spiess Pittsburgh-area food banks say demand is soaring as families struggle with inflation

"We wanted to create something that would make it easy for the families we serve to access our distribution events without having to fill out monthly paperwork," Ms. Kelly said. "A passcard will help someone attending a Food Bank distribution simply scan their card and pick up their food when it is their turn in line."

Individuals can pick up their passcards at the distribution where they originally completed the self-declaration of need form. If the card isn't picked up at the next month's distribution, staff will mail the card.

Anyone interested in signing up for a passcard can attend one of the Food Bank's regularly scheduled distributions, which can be found on their website.


