Good afternoon. Here's what you need to know to end your day.

- Apple plans for a 10% jump in iPhone demand.
- Pelosi deals a blow to Biden's reelection campaign.
- Drake loses a \$300,000 bet at the Copa America semifinals.

Apple announced ambitious plans to increase iPhone sales, counting on AI services to fuel demand after a bumpy 2023.

- **The iPhone-maker** will ship at least 90 million iPhone 16 devices in the second half, targeting about 10% growth in shipments compared with the model's predecessors.
- **Stocks hit a historic high,** with the S&P 500 closing <u>above 5,600</u> as megacaps rallied on the news.
- **Competition remains** with Samsung <u>launching a smart ring</u> and releasing a new high-end wearable with similar features as the Apple Watch.

What Else Is Happening

Nancy Pelosi declined to support Joe Biden's intention to seek reelection, saying instead that it <u>remains his decision</u>. Top officials from his reelection campaign are set to meet with Senate party members on Thursday. NATO allies see his chances of a <u>second term fading</u>.

US Representative Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez filed articles of impeachment against Supreme Court Justices Clarence Thomas and Samuel Alito for what she said was their failure to report gifts and refusal to recuse from cases in which they were conflicted.

In other news:

- **Distressed investors** are turning their attention to <u>troubled real</u> <u>estate</u> assets in the US, with about 64% of property investment targeted there.
- **Layoffs:** Intuit is laying off about <u>1,800 workers</u> in a shift to focus on AI. **CNN will cut** about 100 jobs as part of a <u>plan to merge</u> its news teams.
- **Costco is boosting** annual fees, including an <u>increase</u> to \$130 from \$120 for its executive membership.
- **Bill Hwang was found guilty** of <u>criminal charges</u> stemming from Archegos' 2021 collapse.


By the Way
