Consequences of executive greed come to ahead as Hollywood actors officially declare a strike, announced in a press conference this morning by SAG-AFTRA president and actor Fran Drescher. This follows unsuccessful negotiations between the union and AMPTP over contracts and attempts by the motion picture studio to attempt to 'change the business model' without changing actors' contracts.
