

CASE STUDY

Program Management on a Large Scale

Planning for the new \$273 million Williston Basin International Airport (XWA) began in 2012. Ulteig started working with the City of Williston in 2015 to develop solutions to manage this very high-profile project. Ground was broken on October 10, 2016, and in June 2017 Ulteig began the role as overall program manager. During the project Ulteig managed 29 active contracts, 16 prime contractors, 16 consulting companies and seven tenant projects.

Ulteig's advanced preparation of a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) Airport Improvement Program application resulted in \$112.4 million in funding and allowed the airport to obtain competitive bids and start projects early – thus reducing the project's timeline by approximately nine months.

XWA opened on time, on Oct. 10, 2019, becoming the first new commercial greenfield airport in the U.S. in more than eight years. The project recently was named the 2020 Airport Business Project of the year by *Airport Business Magazine*.


CASE STUDY

Stepping in to Manage a \$350 Million Wind Project

Live Oak Wind Project, LLC is a 200 MW wind energy generation facility owned by Engie North America, consisting of 76 SiemensGamesa 2.625 MW wind turbine generators. Construction began in March 2018 but did not get off to a productive start. Engie looked to Ulteig to get this \$350 million wind project back on track.

Ulteig assumed the role of Owner's Engineer in May, stepping in quickly to develop a full, turnkey solution that included management of the Engineer, Procure Construct (EPC) balance of plant contractor and wind turbine supplier. Ulteig was also responsible for overseeing the procurement and commissioning of the turbine supplier agreement (TSA), main power transformer (MPT) procurement, independent engineer and owner's engineer coordination, ERCOT grid interface and compliance, utility transmission interconnection coordination and COD, close-out and acceptance activities.

Engie has reacted positively to Ulteig's quality of work and the level of dedication invested in making the Live Oak Wind project a resounding success. Engie and Ulteig remain committed to a long-lasting relationship and have collaborated together on the Solomon Forks, East Fork, Seymour Hills and other wind projects.

CASE STUDY

Large-Scale Wind Project Delivered Under Budget

Ulteig was hired by Engie to help with the Jumbo Hill Wind Project, a 160MW wind farm located in Andrews, Texas. Our team provided full scope Project Delivery Services (PDS), including an entire project management team (Senior Project Manager, Associate Project Manager, and Project Controls Specialist) and construction monitoring team (Construction Management Monitor and field observers).

The Jumbo Hill construction project consisted of:

- 57 2.82MW GE turbines with 127m rotor generators
- A 34.5/138kV collector substation with two 140MVA main power transformers
- An underground 34.5kV electrical collection system

Telemetry/fiber connectivity was a major risk and challenge on Jumbo Hill. The only telecom provider available was a company that filed for bankruptcy within a month of Engie signing a construction and recurring service contract. Careful relationship and communication management with the telecom provider proved to be ineffective, as well as engaging Engie's senior legal counsel and VP level influence. The telecom provider's poor performance pushed Jumbo Hill's substation energization by more than a month. Ulteig's expert PDS team took the reins, finding effective solutions to the challenges, driving resolution, and finishing the project on schedule.

Jumbo Hill's delivery construction budget was more than \$175 million. Ulteig's PDS team closed out the project delivery budget with \$2.14 million remaining in contingency. The project finished under budget due to our diligent focus on contract, budget, risk, change, and document management throughout project construction, as well as open communication and negotiation with major contractors.

CASE STUDY

Serving as Owner's Rep for Arvada Bond Project

Ulteig is currently serving as the City of Arvada's Owner's Rep for the W 72nd Avenue Bond project. This CMGC project includes widening W. 72nd Ave. between Kipling and Simms Streets from two lanes to four with all new pavement, curb and gutter, 14 ft shared-use paths on both sides of the roadway, lighting, and landscaping.

It also includes:

- An underpass at the Union Pacific Railroad crossing near Oak St. to eliminate traffic backups
- Drainage improvements and right-of-way acquisition

Ulteig is working as the owner's representative for the city, bringing expertise in the CMGC process. The team is providing services that include design review, value engineering, schedule review, cost negotiations, and public outreach.

Once construction begins, Ulteig will continue as the owner's rep, managing the construction process and fully inspecting, testing, and documenting final quantities and payment. Ulteig also developed a GIS-based right-of-way tracking tool to assist the City with tracking the status of the 84 property easements and acquisitions needed to complete the project.


