MISTAKES YOU DIDN'T KNOW YOU WERE MAKING

Outdoor Furniture

Deck out your patio like a pro by keeping these common yet avoidable errors in mind.

Your Sense of Scale Is Off

Inside, people often get furniture that's too big for the space. On the deck, it's the opposite. You'll likely need bigger pieces than you expect because they're going to look smaller once you put them in place. Before you buy anything, map it out with painter's tape and assess the floor plan.

You Don't Think in Zones

One large patio can actually contain multiple "rooms," such as a dining area, a lounging nook, even a cornhole tournament spot. Consider what's important to you and break up the space with furniture, outdoor rugs, and lighting.

You Pick the Wrong Cushions

A cute pattern isn't the only thing that matters! Darker colors are best, as soil shows up easily on lighter materials. You also want a performance fabric that's dirt-repellent and UV- and mildew-resistant. (We love the Sunbrella brand!) And ideally, the covers can be removed and tossed into the wash.
