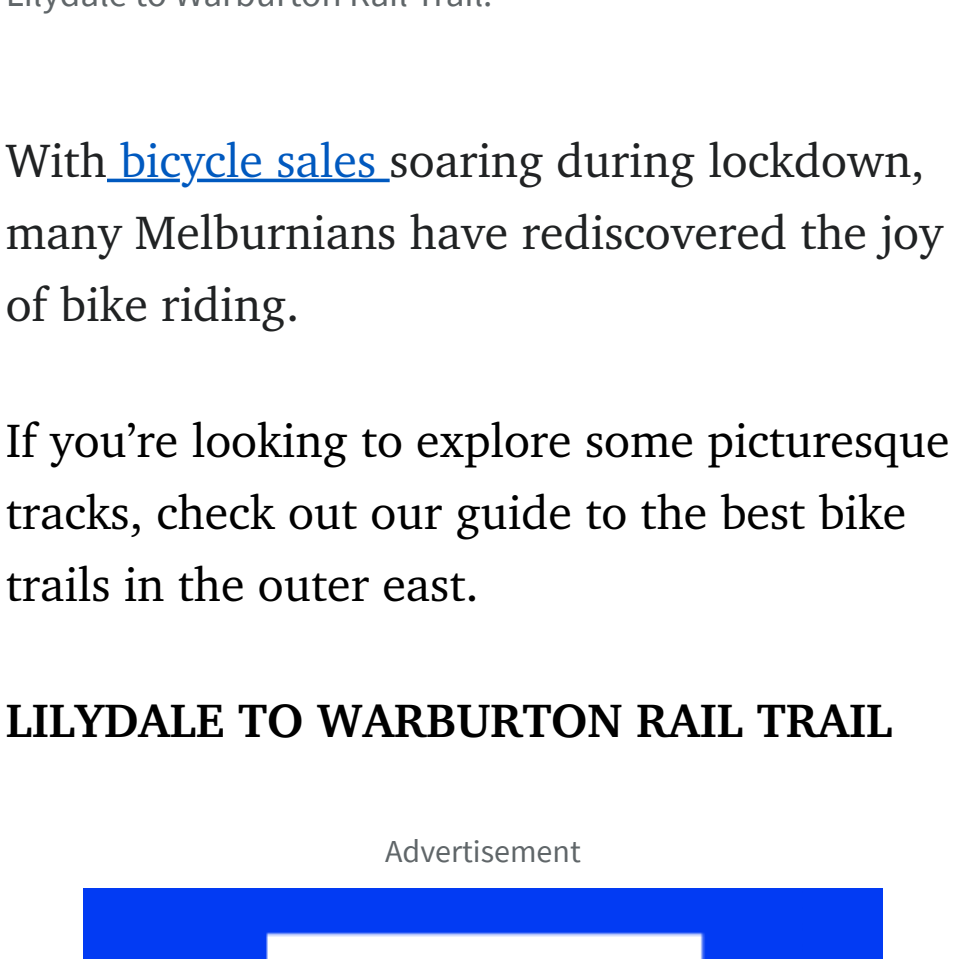

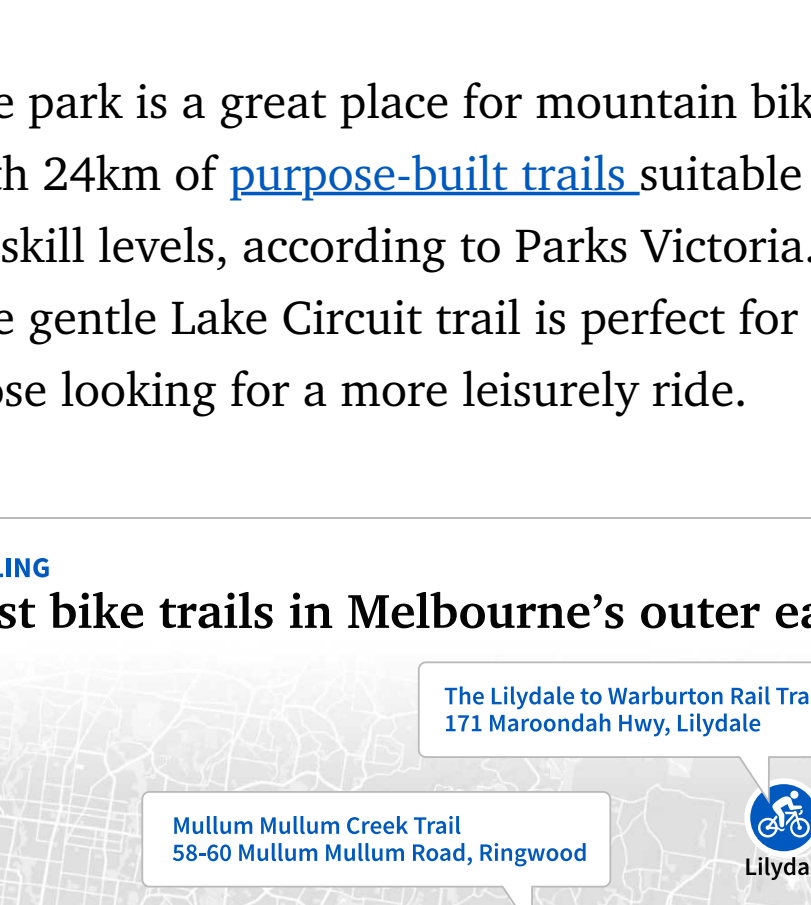

The park is a great place for mountain bikers, with 24km of [purpose-built trails](#) suitable for all skill levels, according to Parks Victoria.

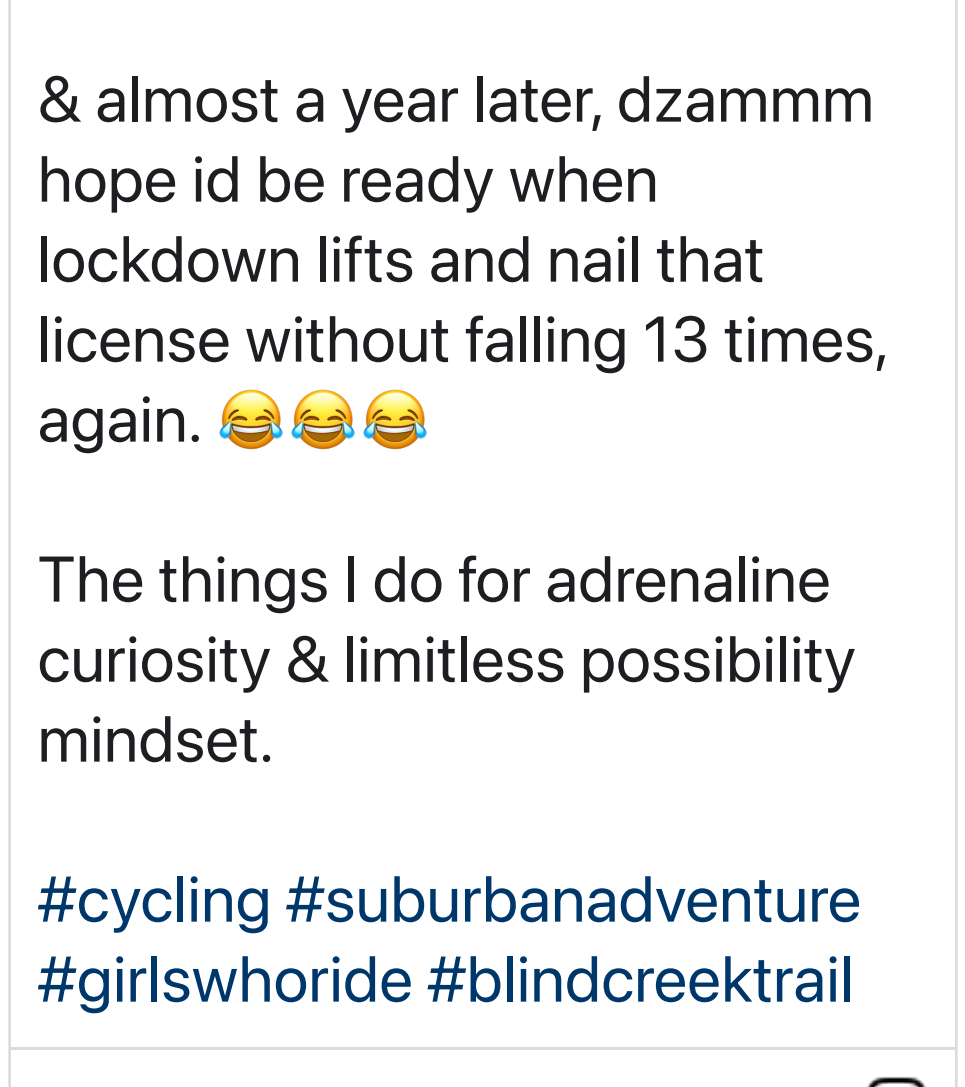
The gentle Lake Circuit trail is perfect for those looking for a more leisurely ride.
