# FRIGHT NIGHT APPS

Dress up a scary-good combo of ready-made apps to fright and delight guests.

## Hot Dog Mummies

This one's a classic. Wrap thin strips of puff pastry around hot dogs, bake according to package directions, then add dots of mustard or ketchup for eyes.

## Spooky Potato Skins

After baking, use squeezable sour cream to make a web pattern overtop each. Or flip them over onto a serving plate after cooling, then carve spooky skull faces into the skins.

## Mozzarella Stick Fingers

Once cooled a little, cut out a small divot from the end of each stick, then tuck a slivered almond (or baked pumpkin seed) into each for fingernails. Don't forget the marinara for dipping!
