The production value for Stranger Things even takes the Netflix top spot, being the most <u>'expensive</u> <u>Netflix original as of 2023'</u>. The creation of Jamie Campbell Bower's Vecna, the upside down and the mind lair, to a name a few, are some of season fours special FX masterpieces, earning them an Emmy award for '<u>outstanding</u> <u>prosthetic makeup</u>' and their third nomination in a row for '<u>outstanding visual effects'</u>.

You may be surprised to know that Vecna's costume took <u>7.5 hours to apply</u> each time he appeared in a scene, which The Duffer Brother's revealed was <u>25 consecutive days</u>. This uncovers a lot about



the integrity of the show as the producers want to give their committed fans a truly immersive experience, putting a lot of money and hours into production.

Considering that she was only 12 years old when she first portrayed the character of Eleven, she nailed the role. In fact, she was so dedicated, she shaved her hair off! Their comedic timing is impeccable and their love for one another is heartwarming.
