Democrats talk Lake O runoff ills, school risk

Gubernatorial candidates slam Scott, Trump in debate

Five Democratic gubernatorial candidates argued Wednesday night over how best to stop toxic discharges from Lake Okeechobee, which have recently caused thick, green algal blooms that are affecting seven Florida counties.

Former U.S. Rep. Gwen Graham, Tallahassee Mayor Andrew Gillum, former Miami Beach Mayor Philip Levine, Orlando businessman Chris King and Palm Beach billionaire Jeff Greene all agreed that runoff from Lake Okeechobee is one of the biggest environmental problems facing the state.
