
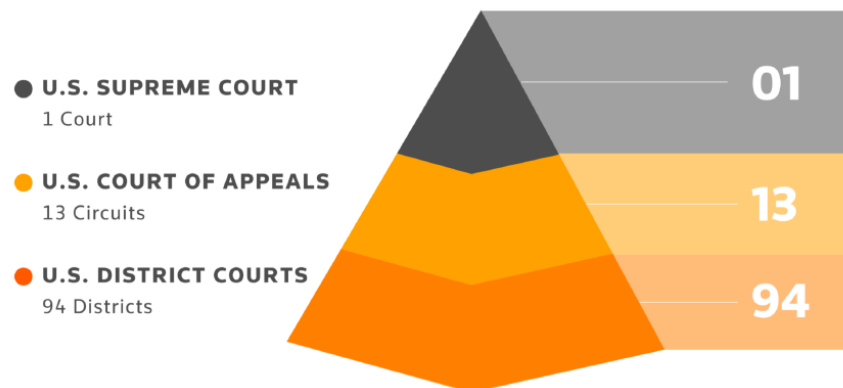




TR Win: U.S. Federal Courts adopt Westlaw Precision

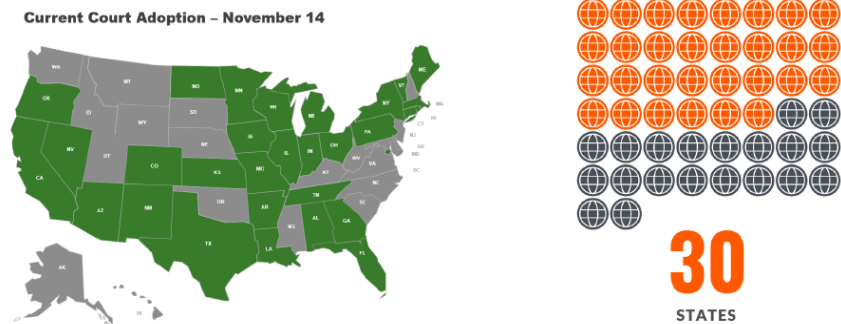
