
Thomson Reuters Selects New Minneapolis-St. Paul Office Location

New office space will maintain company's decades-long presence in Eagan, Minn.

June 29, 2023, MINNEAPOLIS-ST. PAUL – Thomson Reuters (TSX/NYSE: TRI), a global content and technology company, announced that it has selected a new office location in the Minneapolis-St. Paul area, subleasing more than 300,000 square feet at The Landing in Eagan, Minn.

“We’re excited that our new offices will keep us in Eagan, and we see this as an opportunity to continue investing in our Twin Cities operations, our people, and this community,” said Paul Fischer, president, Legal Professionals, Thomson Reuters and co-site lead for the company’s Minneapolis-St. Paul campus. “Employee feedback shaped our search, and our new space will provide the modern, collaborative environment that our dynamic workforce desires. Our employees prefer to split their time between working in the office and from home, and our new space supports a hybrid work model that will deliver an engaging experience for connecting and collaborating with colleagues while in the office.”

Thomson Reuters plans to begin moving into its new location at 2900 Ames Crossing Road, adjacent to TCO Performance Center at Viking Lakes, home of the Minnesota Vikings, in Q1 2024.

The new office provides a flexible space designed to foster collaboration and features amenities including a fitness center; outdoor walking paths; a full-service cafeteria and premium coffee shop; and a deck overlooking Lake Shanahan, which employees can walk around during breaks or for meetings.

Fischer noted the space will be key to retaining and attracting top talent that values flexibility.

“Our new space reflects our commitment to strengthening our leadership position in both flexibility and wellbeing for employees,” Fischer said. “Our work environment is an extension of our supportive policies that empower colleagues to maintain a healthy work-life balance. As we balance flexibility for our employees with the needs of our business and customers, an office space that fosters collaboration and innovation will enable us to best support our customers in better serving their clients.”

“We’re pleased to continue our longstanding relationship with the City of Eagan,” Fischer added. “We’re grateful to Eagan Mayor Mike Maguire and his team for supporting us throughout this process.”

“Thomson Reuters is an amazing asset to our community,” said Eagan Mayor Mike Maguire. “From their industry leadership to the thousands of employees who call Eagan their working home, we know they are a part of our community's success, and Eagan is clearly a part of theirs.
