Learning Resource Center: Students with documented learning needs are able to connect with the Learning Center at ACS. A Student Study Team (SST) determines admission to the program. Input and referrals from parents, teachers, an educational psychologist and medical professionals will set the learning criteria for individual students. Qualifying students will be allowed extended time on classroom exams and certain college entrance examinations.

Academic Travel: ACS highlights community involvement with their Disaster Relief Fund and learning opportunities in Namibia.

Specific Areas of Study:

International Baccalaureate Program (IB): The IB Program is an academically demanding, comprehensive and very rigorous program for students ages 16-18. Those students who desire a more challenging program or other students who need the IB program to gain entrance into the university of their choice, should apply to the IB program.

<u>Advanced Placement (AP) Courses:</u> There are many college-level AP courses offered at ACS. Students are encouraged to take the courses and examinations, in order to receive college credit.

<u>Career Related Program:</u> IBCP (career-related) education incorporates the need for students who would enjoy a curriculum that is career-based in theory. The program is molded into a framework that allows the students and the school to take a different path, but within the principles of the IB program.

Performing Arts: The performing arts are an integral part of the ACS curriculum, with at least six

theatrical productions annually. Students take part in every aspect of production, both on and off stage. The school music program also plays a major part of the curriculum as the students have the opportunity to work with area professionals as well as faculty in all aspects of every production. These performances take place in the 500+ seat auditorium, which opened in August, 2014.



Residential Living

Every student is in a two-bedroom study suite with a private bathroom. The rooms come

furnished with wardrobes, beds, lamps, desks and bookcases. All students have access to the schools new dining hall, laundry facilities, and lounge. There is also WiFi available throughout the Boarding House. Dormers are free to use the sports facilities and pool, as well as the weight training, dance and aerobics studio.

Resident Parents: All boarding students are assigned a "resident parent", or supervisor to help them throughout their time at Cobham. The supervisor will help monitor and guide them with schoolwork or personal situations, should they arise. There are also counsellors and a school nurse on staff.

Sports and Athletics- ACS Cobham is the home of The Cougars! This year, the school was selected as the official training ground for the 2015 Rugby World Cup. Cobham runs different teams from the Middle School, Junior Varsity and Varsity divisions and competes against other international schools in the UK, Europe and Africa. Every year, Cobham concluded its season with the International Schools Sports Tournament (ISST). The school typically competes in basketball, volleyball, track and field, softball, soccer, swimming, rugby, dance, golf and tennis.
