

I'm nervous about the new experiences I am bound to face and how I will handle them. No matter what, I will look at these situations with positivity.










What are your plans after graduation?

I enjoyed being in mariachi and orchestra all four years playing my violin and singing is always so much fun.










What are your plans after graduation?
