Audience-centered communication will increase patient satisfaction in several ways. My role requires teaching patients complex information regarding medical conditions and treatment plans. In managing a high caseload of clients, I communicate with colleagues through charts, messages, and emails to relay changes in patient condition and delegate critical tasks. Through the technical writing program, I am learning to deliver clear written messages through structure, conciseness, and an active voice. Structure, conciseness, and active voice allow the receiver to gain necessary information quickly and clearly. Clarity in staff communication will prevent duplication of tasks, ensure timely decision-making, and encourage collaboration to streamline processes, ultimately conserving resources.

Accurate communication will prevent errors and reduce harm. As clinical coordinator, I document and transmit a high volume of patient health information while constantly multitasking. Inaccuracies in this documentation could result in medical errors such as delayed, incorrect, or absent treatment. The technical writing program emphasizes the ethical significance of ensuring written communication is reliable and accurate, creating a work environment that prioritizes safety. This will prevent errors related to incorrect documentation or lack of documentation, ensuring the clinic is legally protected from medical errors.

Communication improvement will benefit the clinic by increasing patient satisfaction, optimizing team efficiency, and reducing errors. As a means of investing in these mutual goals, consider reimbursing my professional development program tuition of \$2,195.
