HBO First Look : Super Troopers 2

In this featurette, we'll cover all things Super Troopers – from what fans love about the first movie, to what's new and exciting about Super Troopers 2! Using sound bites from the cast interviews and BTS footage, the featurette will showcase:

- Highlights and fan favorite moments from the first Super Troopers movie.
- Major plot points of the sequel – including the comical Canada vs. USA rivalry!
- The incredibly funny dynamic between the cast members and Broken Lizard gang!
- The Indie GoGo supporters and tell the story of how they funded the movie.

We'll wrap up with some hilarious, action-packed, crazy scenes from the second movie to get the fans really pumped up!

Shit On The Mountie Uniform

The Super Troopers gang gives us a tour of the ST2 set, and they come across the costume department tending to the coveted Mountie uniform. The guys stop dead in their tracks – “What the fuck is that?”

This initiates a slew of insults the cast fires at the ridiculous red uniform:

- Good thing the uniform is red, that way you can't tell if you get your period.
- Are Mounties real police officers or the main event at a bachelorette party?
- “Mountie” – that's what I did to your Mother last night.

The costume designer endures all the comments, but then breaks the news to the boys that they'll be wearing the Mountie costume in the film. The Super Troopers look at each other with dumbfounded looks on their faces.

We'll top off this featurette with film clips of the troopers in uniform!

Beer, Beer, Beer

We'll tell the cast they're just getting together for a drinking contest, but really we're conducting a hilarious experiment! For this featurette, we'll divide the Super Troopers cast into three groups: one group will have Canadian beer (which has a higher alcohol content), one group will have American beer, and the last group will be given O'Doul's alcohol-free beer.

Once they've enjoyed a few, or ten, we'll conduct to-camera interviews and give the cast members a prompt that relates to the movie.

For example: Describe the rivalry between the Mounties and the Super Troopers.

It will be absolutely HILARIOUS to see the different responses on all ends of the drunken spectrum (from sober to wasted). This will require one shoot day, some location scouting to find the perfect bar, willing cast members, and lots of beer!

Farva In The Trunk Teaser

In this quick teaser, we'll show the entire cast in their Super Trooper uniforms huddling around the trunk of a car.

Reveal: Farva is in the trunk, bound and gagged. He's desperately trying to break free!

Then we'll end the teaser with a title treatment.

This fun, quick teaser can be accomplished with a quick shoot day, the cast in full costumes, and a car. Easy peasy!

Crackle and Bacon Music Video

For this fun featurette, we'll get the boys together for a Crackle and Bacon music video. We'll get to the Super Troopers themed hits – like "Baby Police Don't Go" and "Cop In The Name of Love". The look of the music video will be delightfully low budget and trashy! Maybe we'll throw in some crazy metal rocker wigs just for fun.

This would require one shoot day, some location scouting, the cast, and a rowdy audience full of Super Trooper fans.

Farva Did A Bad Thing

Farva accidentally recorded his favorite soft-core porn over some of the Super Troopers 2 film footage. To cover it up, he's going to recreate some scenes in the movie by himself and hope nobody notices.

The hilarious part is he is a one man show! Farva will play all of the characters in janky costumes he bought at Goodwill and he'll craft up cardboard cutout versions of the movie sets. This will require 1-2 shoot days to capture Farva shopping for low budget props and costumes, and the actual filming of the low budget Farva version of Super Troopers 2.

Hockey Night PSA

We'll pay tribute to Royal Canadian Mounted Police in a heartfelt, in-character PSA coming straight from the Mounties themselves. They will profess their love for their country, their people, and the dedication to their work. They will sacrifice their lives for the Canadian people if they are in need!

Here's the twist: you can always count on them – EXCEPT on hockey night! They will then profess their love for the sport, and talk about how highly inconvenient it is when their hockey nights are interrupted.

We can accomplish this featurette in one shoot day by having the Mountie cast stand in front of a green screen or white cyc while they read a script from a teleprompter (or use their improvisational skills!).

Halifax Explosion Mockumentary

In Rob Lowe's interview, he mentions how he made a particularly significant contribution to his character that Jay loved: Guy's obsession with the Halifax Explosion. He knows everything there is to know about this tragic event.

In this featurette, we'll create a mockumentary about the Halifax Explosion narrated by Guy LeFranc himself. We'll use photos from the actual event, and maybe throw in some low production reenactments for a twist of dark comedy!



Halifax Explosion: Drunk History (Alt Version)

Like Drunk History, we'll have the cast of Super Troopers 2 comment on and recreate the Halifax explosion. Rob Lowe, who provided the inspiration for this bit, will be the main narrator, while the rest of the Super Troopers cast will star in melodramatic reenactments.

Fans of the Super Troopers movies will love seeing their favorite cast get drunk and weird while doing their best to give a history lesson.

This would require one shoot day with the cast and a lot of booze.

Mountie Training Video

What kind of training does a Mountie go through to actually become a Mountie? We'll explore their training with Broken Lizard flair!

We'll wheel out an old, janky television, give it a few fists bumps to clear up the white noise, and voila - a low quality training video to show to hopeful trainees. The video will tackle the usual subjects: sexual harassment, punctuality, and uniform requirements.

Then, we'll head into the funny stuff:

- How to catch a perp with a strong Canadian beer in your hand.
- The right way to eat a waffle.
- Moose wrestling.

This can be accomplished in one shoot day with the Mountie cast and a few rookies.

The Super Troopers Watch Super Troopers

Remember when Shia LaBeouf watched all of his movies for 3 days, and people watched him watch his movies? Well, we'd love to do the exact same thing with the Broken Lizard gang!

We'll get the cast together in a movie theater and have them watch all of the Broken Lizard movies (or maybe just Super Troopers 2). Throughout the showing, we'll cut back and forth between their reactions/commentary and the movie feed.

They'll laugh, share some memories, and maybe even cry just to spoof good ol' Shia. This featurette would require a movie theater space and the canon of Broken Lizard's work. Unlike Shia's 3-day marathon, this can be accomplished in one shoot day.

Facebook Live: Director's Cut

What could be more fun for fans of the movie to watch Super Troopers with the cast? For this fun Facebook Live event, we'll have the entire cast gather 'round and watch the first Super Troopers in a casual setting. Think someone's living room with pizzas, liter o' colas, and beers spread out on a coffee table.

The cast will invite you to watch the movie with them in your own living room, while they eat and drink to their heart's content and provide hilarious commentary. The cast will be the main event on screen, while the film will be playing in the lower left-hand corner.

This would require one shoot day and the cast of Super Troopers to get together and have a blast watching Broken Lizard's cult classic.



A Day In The Life

In the first Super Troopers movie, we see a lot of the gang in their work environment. But what are they like at home in their everyday life? Each of the cast members will make in-character social pod videos about how they get ready for work. These can be scripted out, or the cast members can use their brilliant improvisational skills.

Farva is just screaming at himself in front of the mirror and trying to get his adrenaline pumping for an action-packed day.

Jay is plucking a few nose hairs.

Mac is in the shower doing a damn good rendition of Kelly Clarkson's classic hits.

This is an easy to execute idea – only requiring the guaranteed comedy from the cast, their cell phone cameras, and some of the cast's free time.

Accidental Improv Show

Kevin thinks he's sending a direct message on twitter, but instead he makes a very public announcement about an intimate Broken Lizard improv show!

Tweet #1: "Hey Jay, can't wait for the improv show tonight at the Comedy Club on Sunset! I forget, do doors open at 8pm?"

Tweet #2: "Shit, shit, shit, shit shit!"

Tweet #3: "Uh...just kidding everyone?"

Tweet #4: "Totally unrelated to my last three posts – how do you delete tweets?"

Next thing you know, Broken Lizard fans will be lined up outside the doors for miles! At the show, the cast will be in-character and up to their usual tricks - like tormenting their audience members as if they're pulling them over!

This would require a willing location, Broken Lizard's participation, and Kevin Heffernan's twitter account.

Chat Roulette

Chat Roulette has quite the reputation – mostly for dudes exposing themselves to anyone and everyone who visits the site. What a perfect environment for the Super Troopers to totally rip into people! It's almost 100% guaranteed that they're going to run into some dudes just letting it all hang out – and they will be ruthless.

- "Hey is it cold where you are?"
- "Do the drapes match the carpet?"
- "Jesus dude, ever think of taking a machete to that BUSH?"

With any luck, the cast will run into a few Super Troopers fans who are ready to chat and make their day/life! This featurette can be accomplished with only a few elements: the cast, a laptop, and of course Chat Roulette.



Silent Disco

For this featurette, we'll throw a Super Troopers themed silent disco party! The attendees will be encouraged to deck themselves out in Super Troopers attire – moustaches, the uniforms while they dance the night away! What they won't know is that the cast of Super Troopers themselves will be mixed into the crowd, dancing their faces off along with the headphone-wearing crowd.

The cast could blend in with the crowd, or act as the bar's staff – a bartender, security guard, etc. At some point in the night, we'll have a big reveal – where the cast will hop up on stage, and make the announcement that they've been partying with them the whole time!

This will require some event planning with a local venue and one shoot day.

Liter O' Cola

A fan favorite moment from the first Super Troopers movie is the scene where Farva freaking out about his "liter o' cola" order at a fast food restaurant.

In a quick, fun instagram video, we'll highlight a liter of cola in all it's glory! It will be resting on a table, glittering in the spotlight, with the Canadian national anthem playing in the background.

Suddenly, out of nowhere, Farva walks in and says "holy shit a fucking liter of cola".

Title treatment: Super Troopers 2! And the video is over.

This quick and easy video will hit home with the movie's cult following and undoubtedly spark the excitement for the sequel.

This will require a shoot day with simple props (essentially just a liter of cola) and Farva's participation.
