

"No one is safe"

A conversation with Neal Horsley, founder of "The Nuremberg Files" Website

Neal Horsley of Carlton, Georgia, is campaigning to be governor of his state. With all the attention he's received from such media heavyweights as *The New York Times*, *Esquire*, CBS and National Public Radio, he finds it surprising so little attention has been given to his political aspirations.

Elective office is just one element of the overall strategy that he and his political party — The Creator's Rights Party — advocate. Horsley wants Georgia — and other states that oppose abortion — to secede from the "godless, perverted United States of America."

Most of the media attention Horsley has received of late focuses on his controversial Website, "The Nuremberg Files," a catalogue of abortion doctors — whom he labels "baby killers" — and others. His celebrity status peaked last month when a federal jury in Oregon ordered that he and 13 other defendants pay \$107 million in damages to Planned Parenthood and a number of doctors.

He says he does not, in fact, advocate violence against doctors who practice abortion. That is only one of a "pattern of falsehoods" reported about him in the press. But in spite of such errors, he admits a heavy reliance on the media. "I have a political agenda that requires me reaching the public," explains Horsley.

Following is a recent interview conducted with Neal Horsley.

Worcester Magazine: Can you explain your work in a few sentences?

Horsley: It's not possible to present it in a soundbite format. That's why I started the Website. It presents my message comprehensively.

The most inconsistent error I see reported is that "The Nuremberg Files" has been defined as a hit list — that has been represented as a fact. But no one can find a sentence or even a single syllable were I advocate violence. Another point that is misrepresented: It's been reported that we post the names of doctor's children. That's simply not true. We do ask people to send that information to us, but we don't post it on our Website.

Then why collect it?

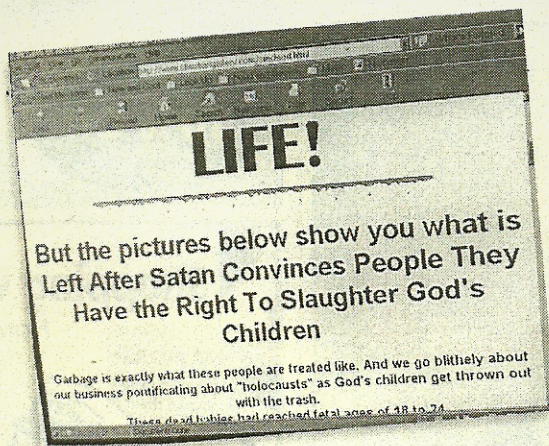
For the same reason the FBI collects that kind of information; so, we'll have it if these people go on the lam. [Note: WoMag found at least one doctor whose sons' names and birth dates were listed on Horsley's Website].

Why include the names of such people as Mary Tyler Moore, Jack Kevoorkian, C. Everett Koop and Ted Kennedy on your Website? They're not performing abortions.

They're on the list for the same reason that Albert Speer was on trial at Nuremberg. He, himself, was not involved in making decisions that resulted in the death of millions of Jews. But he did have a relationship with the regime.

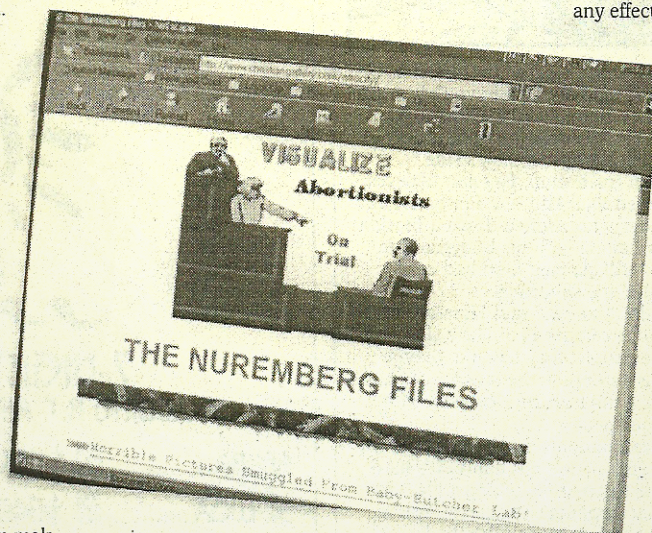
You're equating Mary Tyler Moore with Albert Speer?

They're also exercising their freedom of speech. They're advocating crimes against humanity.

What was your epiphany? What caused you to become so strongly involved in the abortion issue?

Looking at pictures. Seeing pictures of the little fetuses and seeing they have little fingers just like us.

Abortion doctors also have fingers.

See, there you go. You're implying that I'm advocating violence against doctors who perform abortions. It's a false image of what I stand for. I've written four books; I've given hundreds of interviews. Nobody has ever been able to show me advocating breaking the law. The news media has become an agent of misinformation, an agent of falsehood. "CBS News," *The New York Times* — they are subconsciously reporting falsehoods.

What do you advocate for those doctors?
I think they should be arrested, put on trial and, if found guilty, executed.

Do you see comparisons between yourself and [abolitionist] John Brown?

I don't compare myself to John Brown. I compare [convicted killer] Paul Hill with John Brown. I tried to get Paul Hill to join the Creator's Rights Party, but he chose to rise up to this evil instead.

You may not be advocating violence, but it appears you are putting doctors who perform abortions in harm's way.

These people are making a living by slaughtering and mutilating little babies. They are putting themselves in harm's way. They will remain there as long as they do this. I think recent events show that.

Recent events?

Doctors are being shot; clinics are being bombed. People are not going to stand for this any longer. I'm being threatened with prison for stating the facts accurately. It's the words I use — the words I use are causing certain people to be very afraid.

Is that legal?

It doesn't matter. The Constitution no longer has any effect in governing America. Judges have chosen to ignore the meaning of the Constitution.

I understand once your Website is back up and running, you're going to start uploading actual videotape of patients entering clinics on the Internet. Isn't that an invasion of privacy?

It doesn't matter. The law can be whatever anybody says it is whenever anybody says it. So, we'll show people as they go about their business of dismembering and slaughtering and killing babies. I'm sure the courts will object to it. They are already moving us further and further away. They are going to keep moving us until they move us into our graves.

Do you, yourself, feel threatened?
(Long period of laughter) When I had my Website up, I was getting e-mails on a daily basis from people who wanted to kill me.

So you can empathize with how threatened doctors must feel.

It's part of the process. I mean it's not just the babies' lives that are at risk. It's not just those who slaughter babies who are at risk. I'm on the front lines. This is all part of a crescendo of events that this will all lead to. Just as the people in the [Alfred P. Murrah] Federal Building in Oklahoma City realized that no one is safe, people will soon realize that no one is safe.
