Technological innovations abound and eco-savvy consumers are keeping the washing machine market spinning Words Danielle Lett

aundry appliances are big business and look set to clean up the kitchen industry this year. Data from MTW Research's *Kitchen Market Report 2019* indicates that laundry appliances are set to exceed £90m in 2019, with the sector itself maintaining share of the £900m kitchen appliance market. "Consumers have a wide choice in the laundry appliance market, with products ranging from an entry level £150, to £1,500 for some luxury brands," explains Mark Waddy, director at MTW Research.

According to MTW Research, the average retail price of a washing machine in 2019 is around £300-£350, with washer dryers commanding around £100-£150 more (and account for 25% of laundry appliance sales in 2019 by volume and a larger share by value). But for these prices, what is it that people want for their money?

"The continued cost of living has spawned a smart consumer, who is looking for the most cost-effective home appliances," explains Whirlpool's laundry category marketing manager Tailang Bu. "Disposable income has tightened for many consumers and, regardless of their socio-economic position, most are looking to closely manage their cost of living and make their cash go further."

One way to help this is to eliminate having to make two separate appliance purchases – a washing machine and dryer – and instead opting to combine the pair with a two-inone washer dryer. Their allure is easy to see, especially in the family home. "Washer dryers appeal to families that are limited on space, providing a space-conscious laundry solution for the busy family, by simply combining the two appliances into one footprint," explains Indesit's brand manager Sara Bazeley. Not only cutting down on prime appliance space in the home, the consumer's overall carbon footprint is also decreased due to the fact of having one less appliance and contributing less waste materials. MTW's Mark Waddy adds: "Climate change concern is increasingly impacting appliance purchasing trends in 2019, with consumers examining EU legislated 'product fiches' more closely for environmental credentials on energy and water usage."

Another way to promote eco and walletfriendly washing is by highlighting a machine with a larger load capacity, with CDA's marketing manager Steve Corbett saying that "larger machines are ideal for families and the environment, as they cut down on the number of wash loads needed in a week".

In terms of family life, appliances that not only reduce the number of loads, but cut corners and offer ease of use are always welcome. This is due in part to the constraints of the average consumer's work-life balance, with Hotpoint's head of brand Jennifer Taylor saying: "As a result, many consumers are increasingly opting for appliances with timesaving benefits, making their lives easier and allowing them to spend more time doing the things that they love." Thus, manufacturers have taken note, and added functions across the board to ensure doing the laundry is made more efficient where possible. Single-button operated cycles, speedier programmes and the ability to pause a cycle in order to add in stray garments, to name a few.

Retailers will find that appliances with reduced noise output are also another draw for consumers when making their purchases. Research conducted for National Quiet Day,

▶ in partnership with Whirlpool, found that 47% of consumers named the washing machine as the noisiest – and most annoying – kitchen appliance. Thanks to the rise in open-plan living, consumers want appliances that run as quietly as they are efficient. "Asking questions to find out what sort of home environment they live in and where the machine will be situated are a good start. If the appliance is going in an open-plan kitchen, noise levels will be a priority," says Hoover Candy UK's freestanding division business director Steve Macdonald.

Finally, machines that feature smart technology are a welcome addition to many user's routines. Research from Euromonitor International – *Home Laundry Appliances in the United Kingdom, February* 2019 – has found that the largest number of connected appliances sold last year within any major domestic appliance category was of washing machines, with Hotpoint's Jennifer Brand adding how it "represents a strong consumer desire for technologically advanced laundry appliances".

"With 4G living on the rise, and family life busier than ever before, the demand for convenience has spread to home appliances, with customers looking for products that make their lives easier," explains Miele's category manager for laundry, Richard Treffler. "At Miele, the latest technological developments have centred around providing flexibility and convenience, while delivering excellent cleaning results." ■
