WHY IT'S A-MAZE-ING: Set aside a whole afternoon for a visit to this pumpkin patch and corn maze in Dixon. It set the Guinness world record for biggest corn maze in 2007 with a whopping 53 acres, and this year's maze is over 40 acres. (That's big enough to hold the new Yankee Stadium.) It's so large—and so confusing—that the local sheriff regularly receives 911 calls from visitors stuck in the maze.
