After the in-house designer position was eliminated, I built and edited web pages and blog posts using WordPress, and applied strategic formatting and tags for optimum SEO; I worked with outside designers when we needed greater technical expertise.

I was responsible for building our social media presence, and shared content on major platforms and edited team member profiles.

In collaboration with designers and internal teams, I wrote and edited conceptual print pieces and tradeshow signage, and edited copy directly in Adobe InDesign before passing it to the freelancer. When we needed headshots, I found a photographer and managed the Chicago shoot. When we needed a sculptural piece for a show, I sourced and managed the artist.

I wrote press releases and set them up in PR Web. In addition, I wrote sales emails to target markets, set them up in AutoPilot and MailChimp, and created landing pages, providing instructions to web designers.

Concurrently, I held the same responsibilities for affiliate companies **Workforce Go!**, a software provider (*October 2016 to March 2018*), and **xkzero**, a mobile app developer (*April 2014 to December 2016*).
