**INT. MESSY DEPRESSIVE BEDROOM- DAY**

“NEVER AGAIN” by Kelly Clarkson plays as we glance at a messy room riddled with clothes all over the floor. The sound of a hysterical crying woman catches our ears. ZOOMING IN to show the face of a teary Black Woman as she scrolls on her phone in bed. We PULL BACK to see the posters and pictures on the walls. Taking a closer look at the pictures, ZOOM IN showcases three pictures closely.

The first picture is of the teary Woman and what looks to be an older but similar version of her.

The second picture shows a friendly, goofy picture of Three Girls and a Boy, and the last picture is heavily covered in black permanent marker, but you can still see the faint traces of a good-looking Black Man— PULL BACK from the wall and a ZOOM IN back to the crying Woman.

The crying Woman continues to cry, scrolling through her phone. We see more closely what she looks like. We see long, auburn, box braids, hair pulled into a bun, and then we see the oversized, bright, orange hoodie she is wearing- then the face reveal is of a sad, beautiful face.

This is JAZZMIN SERWANA, 22, a recent college graduate living with her mother. Kelly Clarkson’s “NEVER AGAIN” plays quite loudly in the bedroom.

JAZZMIN

(yelling the song)

“YOU’LL DIE TOGETHER BUT ALONE”

The door suddenly opens into the bedroom, and JAZZMIN's mother walks in to let her know her friend is here—suddenly, without any announcement, the friend walks right in, passing JAZZMIN's mother. Her mother walks out of the room.

JAZZMIN looks at her best friend, ELYO GIENO, with a shocked face.

A honk from a car can be heard repeatedly outside JAZZMIN's bedroom.

ELYO

JAZZMIN

(Grudgingly)

Fine, but I will be searching for new friends when we arrive.

ELYO

Well, I mean you just lost your boyfriend can you afford to lose more things...in the sense...that

JAZZMIN

FUCK YOU!

ELYO

(laughing)

Love you, I will see you outside. Get dressed quickly so we can head out.

ELYO walks out of the bedroom. JAZZMIN gets out of bed and gets ready to leave. Grabbed her to-go bag, walked out of bedroom and shut the door.

**EXT. JAZZMIN BEDROOM- DAY**

Hanging outside the door a D.A.R.E POSTER WITH THE WORDING “DON’T DO DRUGS, UNLESS NECESSARY.”

**EXT. OUTSIDE JAZZMINE HOUSE- DAY-CONTINUOUS**

A small green car is outside running parked behind a red KIA. JAZZMIN tossed her bag in the opened trunk, then got inside the car. Now that everyone is in it, the green car backs out of the parking lot and zooms out into the road.

**INT. GREEN CAR- DAY**

A tall White Man, DOLCHE, is driving the green car. His blond, curly, hair is covered in a big, Red Sox hat. Not very muscular but he defiantly had a fit frame. His eyes were a particularly striking hazel and freckles splattered across his face and body.

DOLCHE

(looking back at ELYO)

Is there a reason you skinned, the Grinch, for your new hair ELYO?

The comment caused the whole car to burst into laughter. Even ELYO joined in the unfortunate state of her hair.

ELYO

DIOR

JAZZMIN

ELYO
