The HALO Foundation of Akron, OH to Deliver Aid to Asheville, NC Disaster Victims

Akron, OH – June 26, 2025 – The HALO Foundation of Akron, OH, is mobilizing a dedicated group of students and volunteers to provide critical support to Asheville, NC, on Monday, June 30, 2025. Responding to the ongoing needs of mountain communities devastated by recent disasters, HALO is sending two semi-trucks filled with supplies and will meet a third truck carrying bicycles and cribs to aid families living in makeshift housing or "tent cities."

The HALO Foundation, established in 2003 to raise funds for the Flight 93 Memorial, has since shifted its mission to disaster relief, focusing on underserved communities 6–8 months after initial disaster response efforts have subsided. This year, HALO identified Asheville residents who lack insurance and are struggling to rebuild, particularly in areas where roads were washed out. Recognizing the need for mobility, HALO has raised \$5,000 to provide bicycles, with ongoing fundraising efforts to support additional aid.

- 2:30 PM: Tour of the hardest-hit areas to assess ongoing needs.
- **3:30 PM**: Return to Asheville Regional Airport for departure.
